Alongside this, QE manages and operates a fleet of single and wide body aircraft on behalf of Diwan and Amiri Flights, as well as some other privately owned business jets. In 2022, QE became the world's largest owner and single commercial operator of the Gulfstream G650ER and is also the exclusive launch customer of the Gulfstream G700.

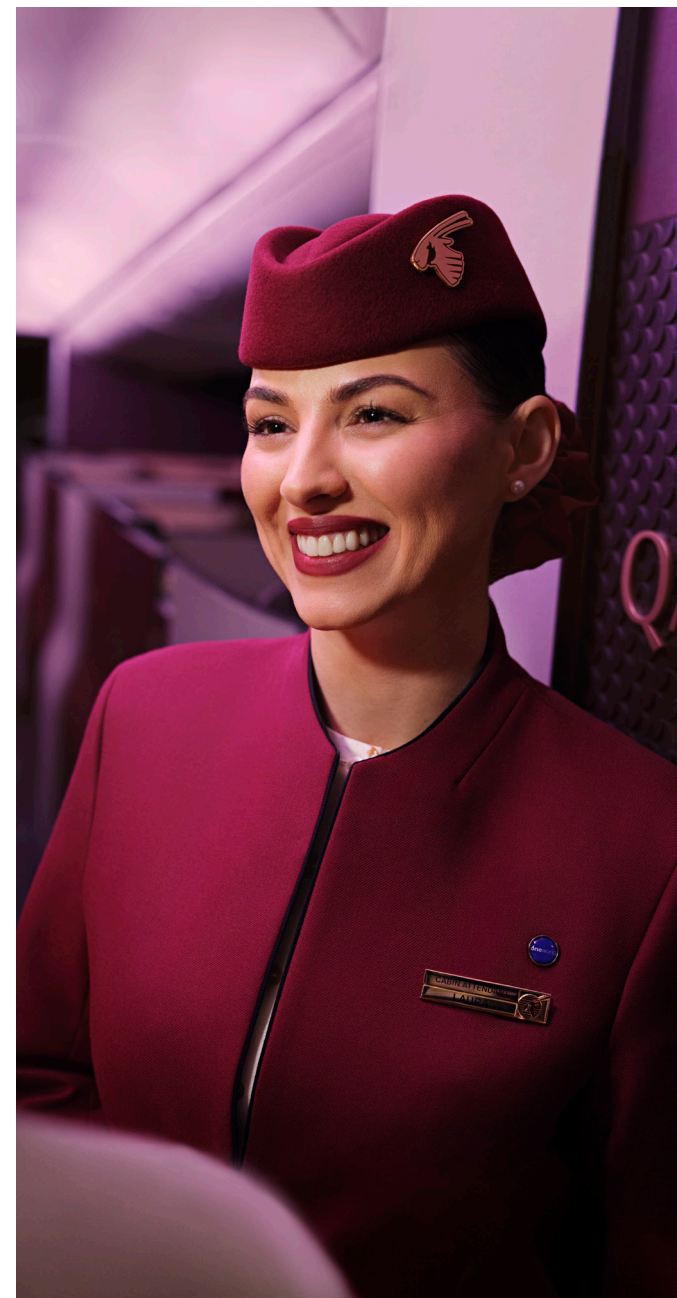
