



# Kaigaro

Very growing leek with particularly long, white shaft. Upright, healthy, green foliage, up to 50 cm long, mild taste, for raw food salad side or cooked. No onion formation, only elongated thickening of the shaft part sitting in the bottom. For early cultivation in the house, under foil, early open land with follow-up sowing until about the end of July. Little winter hardy, wintering only possible in climatically favorable areas. Resistant to diseases.
