Flower Regulations

Carolina Memorial Park is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to flower arrangements, containers or personal items in any location.

1. Floral arrangements are limited to one arrangement per marker or mausoleum crypt, unless a marker has provisions for additional vase or vases. Approved vases are on display in the cemetery business office.
2. New interment site cut flowers and funeral floral decorations and frames are **removed from new interment or entombment sites on the 4th day** after the funeral and disposed of by the maintenance staff, unless earlier removed by those lawfully entitled to the decorations. **Chapel Mausoleum funeral flowers are available 3 days** outside the Chapel, beneath the stained glass; **Plaza Mausoleum funeral flowers are available 3 days** at the Plaza Drive committal site. **Funeral home temporary markers are removed after ninety (90) days.**
3. With the exception of **March's spring and November's winter cemetery clearings***, flowers in bronze vase assemblies will be permitted to remain as long as their beauty prevails or remains in season.
4. Fresh cut flowers may be placed in approved cemetery flower vases and in our Chapel Mausoleum throughout the year. Withered flowers may be removed by the cemetery maintenance staff. Chapel Mausoleum flower height should not exceed three (3) feet; **only natural flowers** (fresh cut or potted) **are permitted in the Chapel Mausoleum.**
5. Vases left standing without any floral arrangements in them will be turned down by the cemetery maintenance staff. Only floral tributes in approved cemetery vases are permitted on the Plaza Mausoleum and Courtyard crypts and niches.
6. Potted plants, flower stands, wreaths and baskets may be placed on interment sites Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day, July 4th and Christmas Day: the Thursday before the Holiday and will remain for 10 days from that Thursday placement date. Such interment site arrangements will be removed and disposed of by the cemetery maintenance staff.
7. The placing of shells, toys, metal designs, ornamental objects, cards, glass, wood or iron cases, lighted objects and similar articles or materials hazardous to lawn mowers shall not be permitted, and if placed, will be removed by the cemetery staff.
8. No holes are to be dug into the cemetery grounds.
9. As a courtesy, temporary markers, if available, will be placed on the grave for 14 days, after which they will be removed.

*** The first week in November and the first week in March, the entire cemetery will be cleaned and all flowers removed. We ask your co-operation by removing all flowers and keepsakes you have in the park before and during these weeks. Your assistance in helping us keep your cemetery beautiful is always greatly appreciated.**
