YOUTH PREPARING FOR CONFIRMATION WILL:

- 1. Be registered online by parent/guardian (link on second page)
- 2. Actively participate in the Religious Education classes offered by SGFP either in religion class at the schools [CJ Middle School, St. Christopher, St. Peter], in the Youth Ministry Faith Formation Sessions or in faith formation through homeschool.
 - Sacramental Coordinator, Elise Sas, will guest teach in each school and at the YM Faith
 Formation program for 4 sessions that introduce direct preparation for the Sacrament.
 However the youth are expected to be in formation (as listed above) for the entire academic
 year. Students receiving faith formation through homeschool should attend the 4 direct
 preparation sessions with the Youth Ministry 8th Grade Faith Formation to prepare with the
 parish community.
- 3. Attend one SGFP Confirmation Retreat at the Maria Stein Spiritual Center in Montezuma.
 - The retreat will be led by the SGFP Youth Ministry Staff.
 - Parent/Guardian will choose one retreat when registering for Confirmation online.
 - Nov. 8, 2025 at 9:00am Nov. 9, 2025 at 11:00am
 - Jan. 17, 2026 at 9:00am Jan. 18, 2026 at 11:00am
 - The retreat is designed to be experienced in its entirety.
 - The cost of the retreat is covered by the parish.
 - Specific information about what to expect at the retreat will be shared with parents/guardians of registered youth closer to the event.
- 4. Choose a Confirmation Sponsor and a Confirmation Name.

Confirmation Mass Guidelines for appropriate attire:

- Youth getting Confirmed should be dressed in "Sunday best" and with modesty to honor the sacredness of the Sacrament.
 - Clothes should be loose enough so as not to cling.
 - Clothes should reach longer than fingertips when arms are pointing down.
 - Shoulders and chest should be covered.
 - o Denim and gym shoes should be avoided.
 - There are no color requirements for Confirmation attire.

Confirmation Sponsor and Name:

Confirmation candidates must have a sponsor, a spiritual companion, to stand up with him or her at the Confirmation Mass.

 A sponsor must be a Confirmed practicing Catholic, in conformity with the norms, laws and principles of the Roman Catholic Church, at least 16 years old and not the candidate's parent (Canon law 874).

Candidates must choose a confirmation name which the Bishop will use at the anointing with Chrism.

- One can choose their baptismal name (their first name) to show the connection between Baptism and Confirmation.
- One may choose the name of a Saint or loved one with whom he or she connects, is inspired by and is a go-to intercessor.

An online form will be emailed to parents/guardians of registered youth to submit the candidates' chosen sponsor and confirmation name.
