

- All those sample sizes of soap, shampoo, and lotions from those vacations ... we can use them.





The above are used to verify parishioner status for sponsor certificates, enrollment in parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, social and pastoral ministries, activities and enrichment programs and use of parish space. No activity shown for one month will move a person to inactive status.

BAPTISM


- 1. Contact the office.
