

#### PARISH MEMBERSHIP

Active members of St. Patrick are identified by their generosity of time, talent, and treasure. Stewardship is determined by:

- 1.Being formally registered and active in the parish for at least one year.
- 2. Faithful attendance to Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
- 3. Regular support of the parish using the envelope or online system.
- 4.Involvement in at least one ministry or organization in the parish.

The above are used to verify parishioner status for sponsor certificates, enrollment in parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, social and pastoral ministries, activities and enrichment programs and use of parish space. No activity shown for one month will move a person to inactive status.

#### **BAPTISM**


- 1. Contact the office.
