



Dress Code 2026-27

Expectations: All students must adhere to the dress code policy. It is important that all dancers are prepared for class upon arrival. NO T-SHIRTS, SWEATSHIRTS, or SWEATPANTS. Dance sweaters may be worn during warm-ups. Do not wear dance shoes outside.

Consequences: 1. Warning 2. Dancer will watch class 3. Conference

General Dance Supplies REQUIRED for each Dancer:

- Dance bag
- All shoes labeled. If shoes are dark, please use a white/silver marker to label inside both shoes
- Hair ties, bobby pins, and brush
- Deodorant or powder
- Band-aids
- Extra tights (dancers should not have holes in their tights)

Hair for female dancers:

Combo 1-4: Hair must be pulled back and away from the face.

All Other Classes: Hair must be secured in a tight bun with hair net.

Dress Code & Shoe requirements for female dancers:

Combo 1-4: Solid color leotard and pink tights. Dancers may wear dance skirts or tutus.

Ballet Shoes: Weissman Full-Sole Ballet Slipper in Ballet Pink. Must order through studio office.

Tap Shoes: Weissman Mary Jane Style Tap Shoe in Black. Must order through studio office.

Pre-Classical Ballet/Beginner Ballet/Ballet 1: BLACK LEOTARD and Pink Tights. Black dance skirts optional but are encouraged.

Shoes: Weissman Full-Sole Ballet Slipper in Ballet Pink. Must order through studio office.

Tap 1/Tap 2: BLACK LEOTARD and tan tights. Dancers may wear black dance shorts or jazz leggings, no flares. RFTS branded Jazz shorts may be worn (available through merch store at rch4thestars.net)

Shoes: Weissman Slip-On Stretch Tap Shoe in Black. Must order through studio office.

Jr Jazz, Beginner Jazz, Jazz /Hip Hop, Jazz Tech: BLACK LEOTARD and tan tights. Dancers may wear black dance shorts or leggings, no flares. RFTS branded Jazz shorts may be worn (available through merch store at rch4thestars.net)

Shoes: Weissman Slip-On Jazz Shoe in Black. Must order through studio office.

Ballet 2-Advanced Ballet classes: BLACK LEOTARD and Pink Tights. Black dance skirts optional but encouraged.

Shoes: Odette Leather Split Sole Ballet Shoes in the color Pink Leather, Bloch #S0246L

ALL Lyrical Classes: BLACK LEOTARD and tan tights. Black dance shorts or leggings, no flares.

Shoes: To be determined by instructor. Ask before you buy!

Knee Pads: Black Knee Pads Style #3500

Intermediate and Advanced Jazz: BLACK LEOTARD and tan tights. Black Dance Shorts or leggings, no flares. RFTS branded Jazz shorts may be worn (available through merch store at rch4thestars.net)

Shoes: To be determined by instructor. PLEASE ASK BEFORE YOU BUY!

Knee Pads: Black Knee Pads Style #3500

Tap 3-Advanced Tap: BLACK LEOTARD and tan tights. Black dance shorts or leggings, no flares.

RFTS branded shorts may be worn (available through merch store at rch4thestars.net)

Shoes: Weissman Leather Lace-up Tap Shoes (Must order through studio office). Students who have already purchased Bloch's may use those.

Modern Classes: BLACK LEOTARD and tan tights. Black dance shorts or leggings, no flares.

Shoes: Dancers are barefoot

Knee Pads: Black Knee Pads Style #3500

Dress Code & Shoe requirements for male dancers:

Combo - Level 2: dancers are required to wear black jazz pants or black or navy sweatpants with a tight fitting white T-Shirts or R4TS T-Shirt

Ballet Shoes: Weissman Full-Sole Ballet Slipper in Black

Jazz Shoes: Weissman Slip-On Jazz Shoe in Black.

Tap Shoes: Weissman Lace-Up Tap Shoe in Black.

All of these shoes are ordered through the studio office.

Level 3 - Advanced: dancers are required to wear a fitted white or R4TS T-Shirt and black jazz pants

Ballet Shoes: black canvas shoe

Jazz Shoes: Men's super jazz shoe in black, Bloch #S0401M

Tap Shoes: Flexmaster lace up tap shoe in black, Capezio #CG16

Modern Shoes: Dancers are barefoot

Other: Black Knee Pads Style #3500 - needed for jazz, lyrical, and modern classes
