Taking top honors was Cody Campbell with 15.63, and Big Bass of 5.65. He concentrated on the Big Sac side, fishing points with pole timber, using a 10 inch Power Worm. He took home \$3,600 for first place, plus \$750 for first Big Bass.

Second place went to Matthew Rogers with 15.39, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Big Bass of 5.19. If you're not scoping, you're hoping. If he's scoping, he's setting the hook! He was paid \$2,500 plus \$250 for his 2<sup>nd</sup> place Big Bass.

Taking third place was Luke Routh with 13.78. Luke caught them out of brush and rock piles with a Motion Fishing football jig. He had one keeper in the morning, and did not have another bite until 1 p.m.
