"What Child is this who laid to rest, on Mary's lap is sleeping?" These words were first penned at the end of the Civil War by 29 year-old insurance company manager William Chatterton Dix. After going through a near death experience, his life was forever changed when he accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior. He began writing poems and hymns in an effort to share Jesus with as many people as possible. His Christmas poem was aimed at helping people discover who the baby born in Bethlehem's manger truly was. His answer to "What Child Is This?" was "this, this is Christ the King." In verse three he added the invitation, "let loving hearts enthrone Him." In 1871, "What Child Is This?" was paired with the tune "Greensleeves" and the rest is history. This Christmas, let's join together to help those without Christ discover what Child this is. Invite others to join you at church this month.
