COLISTENING ASSIGNMENTS

• Jubilate Deo - ALL on PART 3 starting at m. 17

- Great job on this! Patience as you wait to come in!
- Latin pronunciations: Jubilate [yoo-bee-lah-teh], Deo [deh-oh], Alleluia [Aw-leh-loo-yah]
- Be careful to sing the correct pitches on the ending "Alleluia."



• Memorization Goal: 2/26

• Baseball Fever - UNISON & PARTS

- All sing unison from p. 2 m. 11 "I have a problem..." until pg. 7 m. 75 when we begin the rhythmic section.
- Practice your rhythm part (m. 75-107) and make sure you can HOLD IT.
- Taijah, Max and Owen are PART 3 during the rhythm section.

• All Praise to Thee – PARTS 1 & 2

- Everyone sings at the beginning (marked "Voices in Unison")
- Refer to the "Part 1 and Part 2" box above to know which part you are singing. Mark it in your music.
 - Part 1 begins at the bottom of p. 2, m. 10
 - Part 2 splits off at the top of p.3, m. 11.
- We are back to unison at the top of p. 8 (last page)

• Now Let Us All Praise God and Sing - SOPRAN0 1 (top notes on top treble clef line)

- Boys: think high and light head voice!
- The melody of this song uses lots of leaping intervals. In the middle is a softer section in which we are moving stepwise much of the time.

• Little Birch Tree - PARTS & UNISON

- You will receive the sheet music for this at rehearsal 2/26. Please pick up your score on the back table when you come in.
- Recording will be up this week in the portal.
- To listen from YouTube, search "Little Birch Tree Belle Voce" or follow the link below. **There are several versions of "A Little Birch Tree.". The only version of the one like ours is the one by the OSU women's chorale. Please make sure you listen to the correct arrangement.

• All Things Bright and Beautiful – UNISON

- Mark the vocal part in the score. If you do not know how to do this, contact me, please!
- Boys: Take the weight out of it for those high notes; use head voice.
- Don't guess the intervals listen! When you feel confident, sing along.

• Goin' to Sing - PARTS

• The soprano line is Part 1; the alto line is Part 2. Mark your part.

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• Difficult intervals and really interesting rhythmic interaction between parts make this a fun piece to sing, but it's challenging. Listen well.

<u> 🔁 R E M I N D E R S</u>

- Be in your seat ready to SING at 3 pm.
- Listen to your music let it "live with you." Spend 10–15 minutes every day focus, concentrate you are smart, talented kids. You can do ALL of these songs!
- Please make sure your music pages are INSERTED into your 3-ring binder. Also, tabs to mark each song would be very beneficial as we continue to learn and perfect our repertoire.
