Approval of the minutes: Minutes from the December 5, 2024, meeting were approved. Greg moved to approve, Gene seconded and all voted in favor

Action items to review:

Old Business:

- Roxanne provided a brief recap of the two-night parish mission with Tanner Kolina. Evening ended with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
- Roxanne and Gene provided a Monthly Synod Update.
 - There are currently 20 active groups, with 180 people participating and some new groups are still forming.
 - Grant request for \$2000 that Tammy is working on for a subscription to Formed
 - Leadership Peer Advisory group attendance pretty good (leaders of the small groups)
 - Looking for one person with Vision to lead the SET team
 - Mass Year 2: PPC members discussed the 12 week “Parts of the Mass”
 - Friday night March 21: Liturgy Commission putting on “Signs and Symbols of the Liturgy”
- Archbishop Hebda was a speaker at a recent event about the Synod. He will be sending a new letter for year 3 (Reclaiming the Lords Day). Year 4 will become Parents as educators
- Michael provided a facilities update. We are reviewing bids from companies who would do a facilities assessment.
- Michael provided an update on the “Lord, Renew Your Church” Capital Campaign.
 - One part of the campaign is for the needs diocese
 - One part of the campaign is Mary Mother of the Church’s needs
 - Each parish is given a goal (\$1.8M) – 60% stays here and 40% to Archdiocese

- Michael provided a stewardship update: We had 225 responses, averaging \$2,500 per household
 - Catholic Stewardship Appeal this weekend
- Sylvia provided a mental health ministry group update

New Business

- Roxanne discussed a document that has a set of proposed policies and procedures for introducing and approving parish ministry ideas
- Sarah to send out two asks:

 - Send out the above document to ask us to review and provide feedback
- Roxanne provided an update on Eucharistic Adoration (including new hours and a desire to work toward perpetual adoration)
