A Summary of Isaiah's Prophecies

- I. Prophecies Fulfilled during His Own Lifetime.
 - A. Judah would be saved from the threatened Syrian and Israelite invasion (Isa 7:4, 16).
 - B. Syria and Israel later would be destroyed by Assyria (Isa 8:4: 17:1-14: 28:1-4).
 - C. Assyria would invade Judah (Isa 8:7-8).
 - D. Jerusalem would be saved during this invasion (Isa 37:33-35).
 - E. Moab would be judged by the Assyrians within three years (Isa 15–16).
 - F. Egypt and Ethiopia would be conquered by the Assyrians (Isa 18–20).
 - G. Arabia would be destroyed (Isa 21:13-17).
 - H. Tyre would be destroyed (lsa 23:1-12).
 - I. Hezekiah's life would be extended by fifteen years (lsa 38:5).
 - J. Assyria would be judged by God (Isa 10:5-34; 14:24-27; 30:27-33; 37:36).
- II. Prophecies Fulfilled after His Lifetime.
 - A. The Babylonian captivity (Isa 3:1-8; 5:26-30; 22:1-14; 39:5-7).
 - B. Babylon to be overthrown by Cyrus (Isa 13:17-22; 14:1-23; 21:2; 46:11; 48:14).
 - C. Babylon to suffer perpetual desolation (lsa 13:20-22; 47:1-15).
 - D. The conquests of a Persian named Cyrus (Isa 41:2-3; 44:28; 45:1-4).
 - E. The decree of Cyrus for exiles to return to Jerusalem (Isa 44:28; 45:13).
 - F. The joy of the returning remnant (Isa 48:20; also cp. with Ps 126).
 - G. The restoration of Tyre (lsa 23:13-18).
 - H. The perpetual desolation of Edom (Isa 34:5-17).
 - I. The birth, earthly life, sufferings, death, resurrection, ascension, and exaltation of Jesus Christ (Isa 7:14-15; 9:1-2, 6; 11:1-2; 35:5-6; 42:1-3; 50:4-6; 52:13-15; 53:2, 10-12; 61:1-2).
 - J. The ministry of John the Baptist (Isa 40:3-5).
- III. Prophecies Yet to Be Fulfilled.
 - A. The Tribulation (Isa 2:10-22; 13:6-13; 24:1-23; 26:20-21; 34:1-10; 51:6).
 - B. The battle of Armageddon (Isa 34:1-10; 42:13-14; 63:1-6; 66:15-16).
 - C. The Millennium (Isa 2:2-4; 4:2-6; 11:6-10, 12; 14:3, 7-8; 19:18-25; 29:18; 30:19, 23-26; 32:18; 35:1-10; 40:4-5; 42:13-14, 16; 44:23; 49:10-13; 51:3, 11; 52:1, 6-10; 56:6-8; 59:20-21; 60:1-3, 11-13, 19-22; 62:1-4; 65:18-25; 66:10, 12, 23).
