What This Means



0–2 Checks → Controlled

6+ months since last tank cleanout

Visible buildup, residue, or layering



3–5 Checks → Buildup Starting

- Cleanup time increasing
 - More material used during washouts
 - Early signs of inefficiency

6+ Checks → Elevated Buildup

- Slower changeovers
 - Reduced system performance
 - Higher likelihood of unplanned cleanouts
