Checklist

- Call the Social Security Administration at 1-800-772-1213. Social Security benefits include a one-time benefit of \$255 to the surviving spouse or dependent children. You will need a certified copy of the Death Certificate. (www.socialsecurity.gov/survivors)
- Veteran's Administration claim forms can be completed at a Veteran's Hospital, the funeral home or cemetery. The Veteran's Administration provides one complimentary Death Certificate.
- Change the deed on your property and remove the deceased's name from that deed. This is done at the county seat where the property is located. You will need a certified copy of the Death Certificate short form.
- Change the titles and registrations of the deceased's vehicles. This can be done at the DMV. You may use a photocopy of the Death Certificate.
- Contact all life insurance companies the deceased had policies with. Request a claim form or ask for help from the local agent. Send in the claim form, the policy and a certified copy of the Death Certificate (long form). If you need any help, your funeral director can assist you.

Traditionally, life insurance companies require only two documents to establish proof of a claim: a Statement of Claim and the Certificate of Death. Remember, though, that this is just a general statement and your insurance companies reserve the right to request further information or proof if they deem it necessary.

When filling out the claim form, you should have the following information available:

- The policy number(s) and face amount(s)
- The full name and address of the deceased
- His/her occupation and last date worked
- His/her date and place of birth and the source of birth information
- Date, place and cause of death
- Claimant's/Beneficiary's name, age, address and Social Security number

There are several ways of settling insurance claims. In most cases, you may opt for a lump sum benefit, or you may choose to have the money paid to you over a time period of your choice. In either case, check with your insurance agent, financial advisor or attorney to find out which method would be most beneficial for your situation.

- Contact credit card companies to notify them of the death. Some credit cards and charge accounts include a Credit Life Insurance Policy with them. They may want a certified copy of the Death Certificate (long form). If the card is held jointly, find out what documentation is required to change cards into the survivor's name. Ask the credit bureau to assist you in transferring your spouse's credit into your name.
- Gather all of the bills together and make sure you are aware of all the credit obligations of the deceased. Many installment loans, service contracts, and credit card accounts are covered by credit life insurance, which pays off the account balance in the event of the death of the customer.

- Change over all bank accounts and remove the deceased's name from those accounts. You may need a photocopy of the Death Certificate (short form).
- Contact any financial institution where the deceased had a loan and inform them of the death. They will be able to inform you if the loan was covered by credit life and what needs to be done to file the appropriate claim. A Death Certificate (long form) is often required.
- Contact all sources of retirement funds that the deceased was receiving and apply for any benefits that are due to you. You may need a certified copy of the Death Certificate for this.
- Change all utilities from the deceased's name. Many, if not all, of these accounts should be placed in a joint account with another family member to help in processing future estates.

Note: If a company requests a certified copy of the Death Certificate, but are not providing you with a benefit, allow the company to pay for their own certified copy, i.e., a life insurance company will pay the claim for life insurance, so you need to provide them with a certified copy of the Death Certificate; a health insurance company, on the other hand, just needs to stop coverage. Allow them to provide their own certified copy of the Death Certificate if they require one.

- Review your own insurance needs. Often, these needs can change after the death of a family member or other loved one. Good organization of your own insurance information can aid survivors at the time this information is needed.
- If you have a large estate, you may want to consult an attorney. If you use an attorney, you will have to pay for their services.
- Keep extra copies of the Death Certificate to send with your income tax returns if you still file.
- Deceased's Will must be probated and estate administered. You should contact the executor of the estate and they will formally offer the Will in court. You will need a certified Death Certificate.
- Go online to oregonlaws.org Statue # 114.515 & 114.505 for probate limits.
