Making sense of benefit terms

Wondering what the dental benefit terms mean? We've put together the **5 key terms** you should know and explain them here.



Annual Maximum is the total amount your plan pays for your dental care within one benefit period. For some plans, preventive and diagnostic services don't count toward your annual maximum, which means you won't pay for things like cleanings and X-rays.



Coinsurance is what you pay toward your dental bill after we've covered our share. For example, if your plan covers 80% of the cost for fillings, we'll pay 80% and you're responsible for the remaining 20%.



Deductible is the initial out-of-pocket amount you pay before your plan begins covering your expenses. For instance, if you get a bill for \$1,000 and your deductible is \$250, you're responsible for \$250 before we pay the remaining \$750.



Confirmation of Treatment and Costs (COTC), also known as predetermination, is a document that gives a detailed breakdown of the costs associated with the treatment, including what portion will be covered by your plan and what your out-of-pocket costs might be. Ask your dentist for a COTC before any major dental treatment so you fully understand your expenses in advance. Once available, you can access your COTC through your MySmile account.

Making sense of benefit terms, cont.



Explanation of Benefits (EOB) is a document you receive after your treatment. It shows how much of your coverage was applied to your treatment, how much coverage you have left, and the amount of out-of-pocket costs you may be responsible for.

Have vision benefits through Delta Dental?



If you have vision benefits through our DeltaVIsion plan,

your Delta Dental ID number also serves as your vision ID. To access your vision benefits, log in to your MySmile account and click "Vision Login" under "Quick Links" on your dashboard. This will take you to your VSP dashboard, where you can view your vision benefit details.

Note: If you have vision coverage only (no dental), your MySmile account will not show dental benefits, but you can still use your ID number to access your VSP information through the Vision Login link.
