- Proven experience as a teacher is preferred.
- Thorough knowledge of teaching best practices and legal educational guidelines partnered with a willingness to follow the school's policies and procedures.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including working in culturally diverse teams.
- Well-organized, committed, creative and energetic.
- Strong moral values and personal discipline.

You will be responsible for preparing and implementing a full educational teaching plan according to the school's requirements and syllabi. It will be fundamental to provide both knowledge and instruction to students whilst also helping them develop their skills in competencies across the European Competency framework.

Responsibilities:

- Effectively teaching Physics, including appropriate lesson preparation and assessment of students in line with school policies.
- Collaborate with fellow staff members within the science team and the broader staff community.
- Communicate appropriately with students and parents.
- Performing break, substitutions, and other duties during the school day.

- Contributing to the wider life of the school in areas such as special projects, presentations, school open days, parent-teacher meetings and planning and attending field trips.
