LIVING LEGENDS

Last season, Max Murphy took over the franchise home run record of the legendary Reggie Abercrombie who hit 92 while wearing the now retired number 11. Later that season, Max hit his 102nd Goldeye home run, and is one of two players in American Association history to hit 100 home runs for a single team. Jabari Henry is the other.

2026 FISH

The Goldeyes enter the 2026 season following their lowest record since the 2018 season in which the Goldeyes went 41-59. 2025 saw the team play in 34 one-run games which they went 10-24. Last season the health of the pitching staff was the main concern with the rotation dealing with injuries once players broke camp. The 2026 squad will feature seven returning pitchers and five position players. Not listed is the return of Adam Hall who played in six games in 2024. The main difference of the team is the youth of the ballclub. Veterans like Mitch Lambson, Max Murphy, Landen Bourassa, Kevin Garcia, Ramon Bramasco, and Jiandido Tromp will lead the clubhouse. It is the youngsters Noah Marcelo, Derrick Cherry, Arji Fransen and Kevin Vaupel will be fun to watch on the diamond in the new season.

Lambson pitched brilliantly in the 2024 postseason run, in two elimination games. Earning wins in both efforts, his 6.2 innings with 11 strikeouts vs Fargo-Moorhead was the start the Fish needed to send them back to the Wolff Cup Final for the first time since the 2017 season

Pitcher of the Year

Moving from the bullpen to the starting rotation in 2018. In 2019, Lambson put together a historic season. Posting a 13-3 record and an ERA of 3.03 (5th in league), including setting a new Goldeyes record for single season innings pitched with 150.2. In 13 of the 21 starts made, he held the opposition to two runs or less. His 133 strikeouts was 2nd in the league behind Austin Wright of Chicago
