Today's Matchup

The Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks (53-47) return to the American Association playoffs for the sixth straight season, opening up the West Divisional Series against a familiar foe in the Winnipeg Goldeyes (54-46). First pitch in Game 1 at Newman Outdoor Field is set for 7:02 p.m.

Last Time Out

The RedHawks wrapped their 2026 regular season campaign with a series victory over the East Division Winners in the Milwaukee Milkmen. They never scored more than five runs in any singular game, but allowed just nine total runs over four games to get the job done, including pitching their first shutout of the year in the season finale.

Fish vs. Feathers

The Goldeyes and RedHawks have a long and storied playoff history against each other. Going back to the days of the Northern League, this will be the 13th all-time meeting between the two clubs. F-M currently holds the advantage, with a 7-5 record in the overall series and a 24-22 overall playoff record against the Fish.

Fargo-Moorhead Postseason History

Dating back to their inception in 1996, this will be the 23rd all-time playoff appearance for Fargo-Moorhead. It is their sixth straight postseason berth and their ninth appearance since joining the American Association in 2011.

The Hawks have won six championships in their history, with titles in 1998, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010 and 2022. Their most recent victory is their lone title in the AA, a five-game set over the Milwaukee Milkmen.

Heading into the 2026 postseason, the RedHawks have advanced past the first round of the playoffs five out of their last six tries, the lone early exit being in 2023 to Sioux City.

Recent Streaks/Performances

The RedHawks pitched their first shutout of 2026 on Monday thanks to a combined effort from Bryce Brassfield, Kolby Kiser, Jon Beymer and Justin Lopez. They allowed just three hits and four walks, punching out 14 Milkmen. On offense, Tucupita Marcano has smacked a hit in 6 of his last 7 games.

Playoffs? We’re Talking About Playoffs?

The 2026 regular season was a historic one for offenses around the league, but the old adage that “pitching wins championships” will put that to the test. Kansas City and Sioux Falls matchup in a battle of the AA’s best and worst pitching staffs by ERA. Milwaukee against Cleburne and Lake Country against Kane County rounds out the first round.

“The Sermonator”

Jose Sermo embarked on a historic season for F-M, breaking multiple club records. He clubbed a record 33 home runs, four more than the previous best. He also drove in 104 runs, one more than Darryl Motley in the club’s inaugural campaign in 1996. Finally, he collected 230 total bases, besting Joe Mathis in 2006 by one.

On The Leaderboard

Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks littered the leaderboards across the American Association this season. Jose Sermo ranked second in home runs, RBI and total bases. Tripp Clark finished runner-up in the batting title race. Tyler Jeans finished fourth in saves with 17, while Kyle Crigger posted the fifth lowest qualified ERA with a mark of 4.21.

The Keys To Victory

The RedHawks have performed at their best when getting on the board early, posting a 33-12 record when scoring first. They also have recorded 44-7 record after leading through six innings, and have lost just one contest when heading into the ninth with a lead. They are also 16-10 in one-run contests, making plays when it matters most.

Kyle Crigger has put together a rock solid campaign in 2026 for Fargo-Moorhead, a much needed performance in a season dominated by offense. Crigger posted the fifth-best ERA among qualified pitchers in the AAPB with a mark of 4.21, and the lowest ERA among RedHawks starters. His strikeout-to-walk ratio sits at 3.0, building off his strong 2025. He has twirled ten quality starts in 2026, the most of any RedHawk. Over 102.2 innings of work, Crigger has consistently put the RedHawks into a position to win. He walked away with a no-decision in the RedHawks season opener in Cleburne, tossing seven innings of one-run ball. He posted a streak of five straight quality starts in June, allowing just 10 earned runs over 32 innings. Against Sioux Falls on August 26, he tossed seven shutout innings, striking out six batters.
