Tasting Notes

Our Syrah at Larner Vineyard is planted in deep, sandy soils over a chalk bedrock. A single row of Viognier is harvested and co-fermented with the Syrah, adding complexity and a floral lift to the finished wine. The 2022 Larner has refined tannins with, violets, white pepper and sage on the nose, with blackberries, stone fruits of prunes and figs. Notes of Kalamata olives and Ethiopian coffee add to the complexity of this fine wine.
