2023 Grenache Blanc

Santa Barbara County AVA

This Grenache Blanc was grown in North-Central Santa Barbara County, just south of the town of Santa Maria. Long, warm days and cool evenings produce luscious fruit with good acidity.

This is our New World take on the back-bone varietal of the white wine blends in the Chateauneuf du Pape region of Southern France. The wine possesses an intense nose of white flowers, melon, white peach and Asian pear. Flavors of pear, green mango, sugar cane and flower dominate the palate, with good acidity lifting the wine's robust weight.

Drinking great now, hold for no more than 4-5 more years.

Composition: 100% Grenache Blanc.

Barrel Aging: 8 months, 50% Neutral Oak, 50% stainless steel tank.
