Wine Notes

The 2023 is our second year using the concrete tank as a fermentation and aging vessel for over half of the Santa Barbara County blend. Red flowers, cardamon and cinnamon are picked up in the initial aromatics. Punchy blue and red stewed fruits, strawberry-sundae-syrup and red licorice follow on the palate. 2023 carries on our tradition of producing focused, intriguing Grenache that tastes great upon release, but also evolves with age.
