Wine Notes

Each year the Petite Sirah is one of our darkest and most powerful wines and the 2023 is no exception. The color is an inky purple so dark its almost black, with aromas of black berry and black currants up front, framed with graphite, licorice and lavender elements. A silky texture and full body, this wine has appeal in its youth but also possesses the structure to age well for a decade.
