



Over the next 2-5 years





Cybersecurity solutions

- Be suspicious of all emails recognise those with dubious email addresses (like Warren Buffet's gmail) and attachments
- Never give over personal or workplace information, particularly financial, requested through emails
- Ensure your internet security software filters malicious emails
- Have a good, offline backup of all critical files
- If you do experience a data breach, this is very likely also a privacy breach – report it to the Privacy Commissioner within 72 hours.




