## Eleventh Sunday In Ordinary Time Reflection

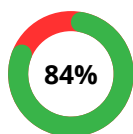
*In the gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowds and is “moved with pity” because they are “like sheep without a shepherd.” Christ does not ignore suffering; He feels it deeply. He sees the wounded, the forgotten, and the weary. Then he says, “The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few.” The problem is not that God has abandoned the world, but that too few Christians are willing to serve the wounded world with God’s compassion. Jesus then calls the twelve apostles and sends them out. Notice that he sends ordinary people: fishermen, tax collectors, imperfect men with fears and weaknesses, yet he entrusts them with an extraordinary role to heal, proclaim hope, and bring the kingdom of God near. Their mission is also ours. We are called not only to worship in church but to carry God’s mercy into classrooms, neighborhoods, hospitals, homes, workplaces, and communities.*

*There is something especially powerful in Jesus’ final words: “Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give.” The disciples are reminded that grace is never earned or owned. It is a gift meant to flow outward. A kind word, a listening ear, forgiveness, advocacy for justice, care for the lonely, teaching truth with love, these become ways we continue Christ’s mission today. Perhaps the greatest challenge of this gospel is to learn to truly see people the way Jesus sees them. Behind many smiles are hidden battles. Behind anger is often pain. Behind silence is loneliness. Jesus looked at the crowds and saw not strangers, but beloved sheep in need of a shepherd. This Sunday invites us to ask ourselves: When people encounter me, do they experience judgment or compassion? Do I notice those who feel forgotten? Am I willing to become a laborer in God’s harvest? The world does not need more successful people; it needs more compassionate disciples. It needs people whose hearts are moved the way Christ’s heart was moved. And maybe, somewhere near us this week, there will be someone quietly sitting in their own kind of darkness, simply hoping to feel seen.*

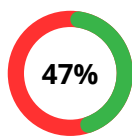

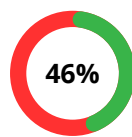
