Photography, Privacy & Media Policy

Purpose:

Oceania United Netball Club is committed to protecting the privacy, safety and wellbeing of all members while promoting club activities in a positive and respectful manner.

This policy outlines how personal information, photography, videography and social media communication are managed across club activities and events.

1. Scope

This policy applies to all club members and participants, including:

- Players
- Parents and guardians
- Coaches and team officials
- Volunteers and committee members
- Spectators and supporters

It applies to all club activities, competitions, training sessions, events and online communication connected to Oceania United Netball Club.

2. Collection and Use of Personal Information

The club collects personal information such as names, contact details and medical information for registration, communication and player welfare purposes.

Information is stored securely and is only accessible to authorised club personnel.

Personal information will not be shared outside the club, Swan Districts Netball Association or Netball WA without consent unless required by law.

3. Photography and Videography at Matches

Photography and video recording at Swan Districts Netball Association (SDNA) venues is prohibited without prior written approval from the SDNA Match Day Office.

This rule is in place to protect the safety and wellbeing of all participants, particularly children and vulnerable individuals.

Members, families and spectators must not photograph or record matches unless approval has been granted by SDNA on the day.

4. Photography at Club Activities

The club may take photos and videos at club-run activities such as:

- Training sessions
- Team photos
- Presentations and awards
- Fundraisers and social events

Images may include players as well as parents, siblings and supporters attending club activities.

Permission for photography and media use is requested from families and may be reconfirmed periodically, particularly when new club media platforms or publications are introduced.

Families may choose:

- For their child and family members to appear in club media,
- For their child to appear but not parents or family members, or
- For neither child nor family members to appear.

Families may request that images of themselves or their child not be used. The club will make reasonable efforts to ensure individuals are not featured or are blurred or removed where possible before images are published.

As club activities occur in public sporting venues, incidental inclusion in background images may occasionally occur despite best efforts to manage preferences.

No personal identifying information will be published without consent.

5. Social Media & Communication Standards

Members are encouraged to engage positively when communicating or posting online in relation to the club.

Members must:

- Be respectful, inclusive and positive
- Avoid negative or harmful comments about players, officials or other clubs
- Respect privacy and confidentiality
- Not share personal or sensitive information without consent
- Avoid bullying, harassment or inappropriate behaviour online

Only authorised personnel may post official content on club social media pages.

Use of club logos, uniforms or branding in public posts or promotional material requires committee approval.

6. Member Responsibilities

Members have the right to request removal or non-use of images of themselves or their children.

Breaches of this policy may result in disciplinary action and may also be referred to SDNA where relevant.

7. Reporting Concerns

Concerns regarding photography, privacy or social media use should be reported to the club committee.
