- Major hotels, upscale restaurants, and some retailers accept credit cards, but travelers should also carry local currency for markets, tipping, and smaller vendors.

## Health & Travel Notes

- A valid Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate ("Yellow Card") is required for entry into both Ghana and Nigeria. Travelers should receive the vaccine at least 10 days before departure.
- Consult your physician or travel clinic regarding malaria prevention medication and additional recommended vaccinations before travel.
- Requirements can change, so travelers should verify entry regulations with the Ghana and Nigeria embassies prior to departure.
