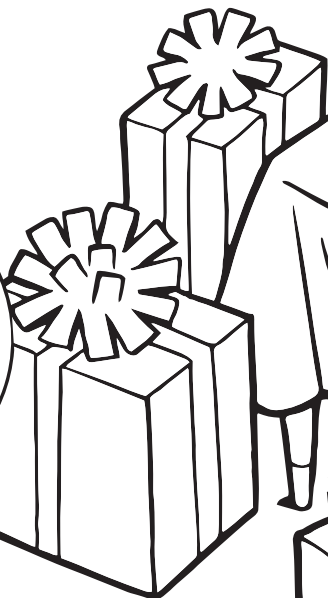

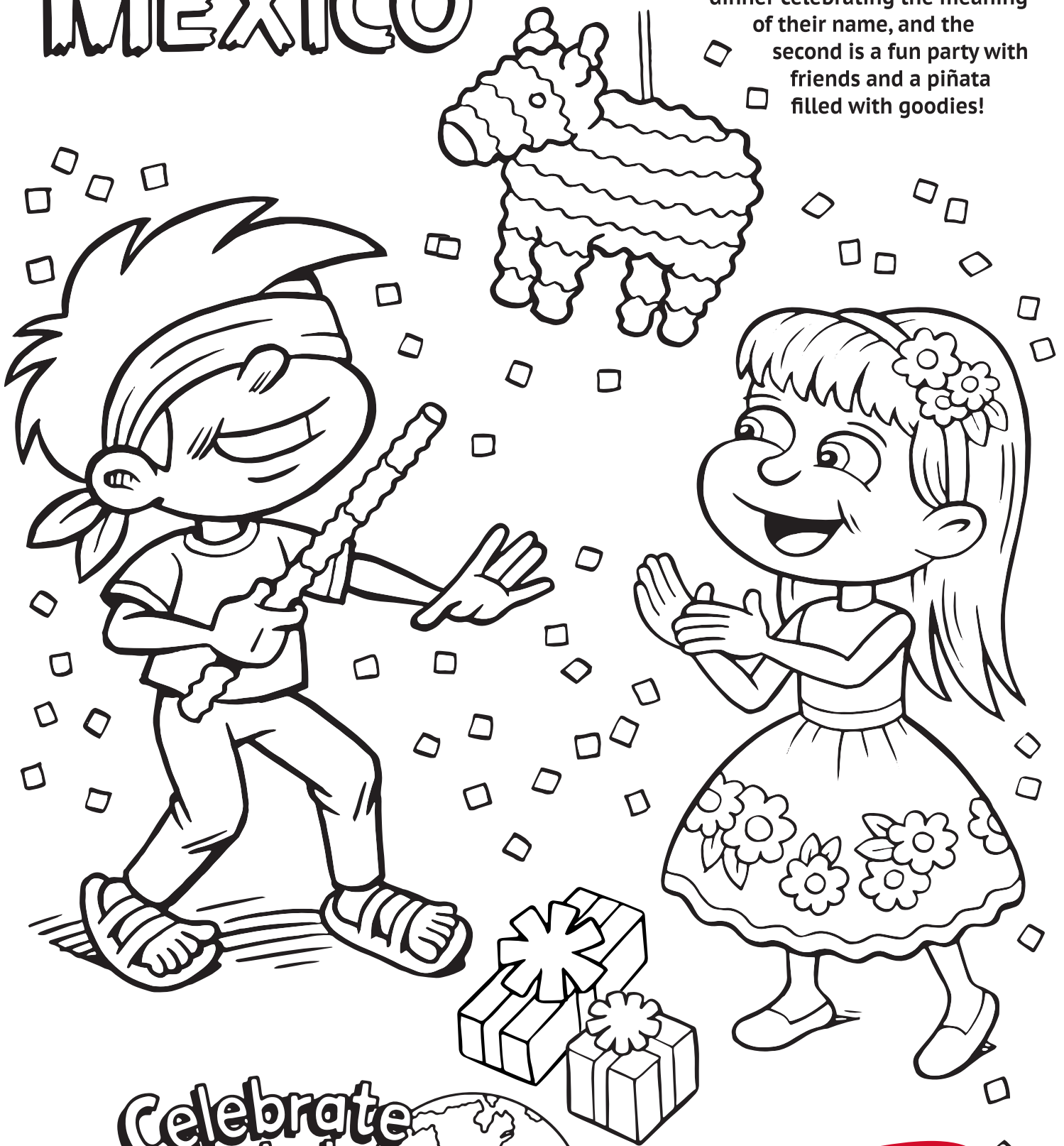
NIGERIA
