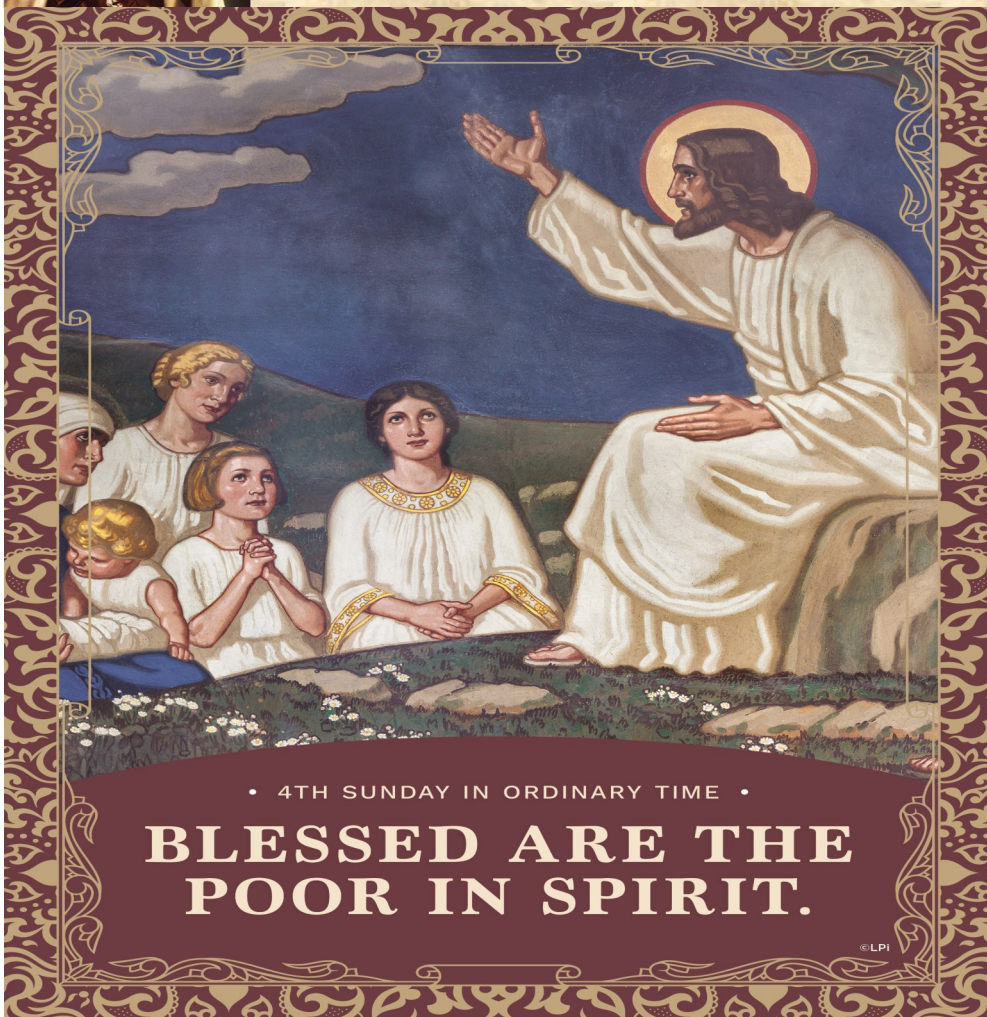

PASTOR'S COLUMN:

Today's gospel reading is from the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount from the Gospel of Matthew. Matthew, as you know, was addressed first of all to Christians of Jewish heritage. This Gospel has 67 quotations from Hebrew Scriptures showing how Jesus is the fulfillment of the prophecies. It also contains many parallels to Moses, the Giver of the Law, the Ten Commandments. Just as Moses climbed a mountain, Mt. Sinai to receive the law of God, so Jesus climbs a mountain to impart the new law. The basic theme of the Sermon on the Mount is that our exterior actions need to be a reflection of our interior attitudes. To be a disciple of the Lord, we first need to adopt the attitudes, the ways of thinking, the desires of the Lord. And so, Jesus presents the Beatitudes.

We have heard the Beatitudes many times, perhaps so many times that we can pass over their meaning. We might think of them as idealistic goals, but actually they are realistic demands. These are not just poetic phrases, they are guides for us on how to be disciples of the Lord. The eight beatitudes begin and end with the phrase "theirs is the Kingdom of heaven."

Lent is just around the corner; February 18! This might be a good time to examine my life as a Christian and see what might need some work. How do my exterior actions need to be a reflection of my interior attitudes?

COLUMNA DEL PASTOR :

La lectura del Evangelio de hoy proviene del comienzo del Sermón de la Montaña, según San Mateo. Como saben, el Evangelio de Mateo estaba dirigido principalmente a los cristianos de origen judío. Este Evangelio contiene 67 citas de las Escrituras hebreas que muestran cómo Jesús es el cumplimiento de las profecías. También presenta muchos paralelismos con Moisés, el dador de la Ley, los Diez Mandamientos. Así como Moisés subió al monte Sinaí para recibir la ley de Dios, Jesús sube a una montaña para impartir la nueva ley. El tema central del Sermón de la Montaña es que nuestras acciones externas deben ser un reflejo de nuestras actitudes internas. Para ser discípulos del Señor, primero necesitamos adoptar las actitudes, la forma de pensar y los deseos del Señor. Y así, Jesús presenta las Bienaventuranzas.

Hemos escuchado las Bienaventuranzas muchas veces, quizás tantas que podemos pasar por alto su significado. Podríamos considerarlas metas idealistas, pero en realidad son exigencias realistas. No son solo frases poéticas, sino guías para nosotros sobre cómo ser discípulos del Señor. Las ocho bienaventuranzas comienzan y terminan con la frase «de ellos es el Reino de los cielos».

**Saint Theresa Parish
Year to Date Statement of Income and Expenses
For the Five Months Ended November 30, 2025**

The first five months of our fiscal year showed a net loss from operations of \$22,963. This was favorable to budget by \$47,008 for two primary reasons. First, we had a one-time income item of \$13,213 which was the Federal Employee Retention Credit payment for the employee positions maintained during the Covid Epidemic. Second, payroll expenses were favorable to budget because we were not fully staffed for July through October. The remaining seven months of December through June are projected to produce an approximate total operating net income of \$33,000. We expect to have an operating net income for the twelve months of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026 of approximately \$10,000 primarily because of the two one-time items listed above.

By the end of January, we will be producing a monthly accounting of the restricted revenue received from the activities of the 135 Ministry and the Columbarium Niche sales. We will report major repair and replacement expenditures paid for with these restricted revenues. We will also be reporting anticipated future major repairs and replacements. We know that we have over \$2,700,000 in anticipated major repairs and replacements in the next fifteen years. We need the Columbarium to start producing a steady cash flow, augmented by the 135 Ministry's efforts, in order to have the funds available to cover these anticipated expenditures.

In the first five months of this fiscal year, we have spent \$75,084 on two major repair items. These were reroofing of the Parish Hall and the HVAC units in the youth room of the main church building. Before the end of the current fiscal year we expect to have repaired the exposed wood beams, originally estimated at \$150,000 but perhaps costing more.

Qualified Charitable Distributions / IRA Rollover

You can make a donation to the Parish directly from your IRA. This type of donation is known as a "qualified charitable distribution". This allows individuals age 70 and ½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to directly transfer up to \$100,000 annually from their IRA to the Parish, tax free. If you are age 73 or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution. Please contact your income tax professional.

Gifts in a Will or Trust

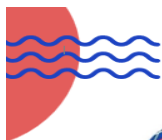
