La Coronilla a la Divina Misericordia es una oración de intercesión invocando la misericordia de Dios sobre el mundo entero, utilizando palabras extraídas de *El Diario de Santa Faustina María Kowalska*. Santa Faustina fue una monja polaca que recibió visiones de Cristo implorándole que divulgara el mensaje de su Divina Misericordia, específicamente mediante la recitación de esta coronilla.

La Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia se reza utilizando un rosario común de cinco decenas. Para comenzar, haz la Señal de la Cruz, luego reza un Padre Nuestro, un Ave María y el Credo de los Apóstoles. En cada una de las cuentas grandes (donde se reza el Padre Nuestro), se dice: “Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo y la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de tu amadísimo Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, como propiciación de nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero.” En cada una de las 10 cuentas pequeñas (donde se reza el Ave María), se dice: “Por su dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero.” Este patrón se repite en las cinco decenas del rosario. Para concluir la coronilla, se reza tres veces: “Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero.”

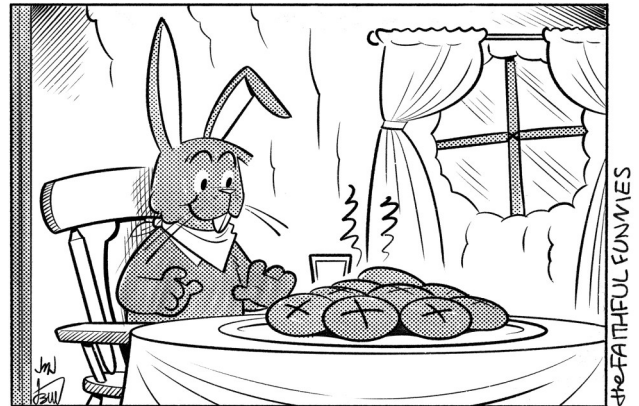

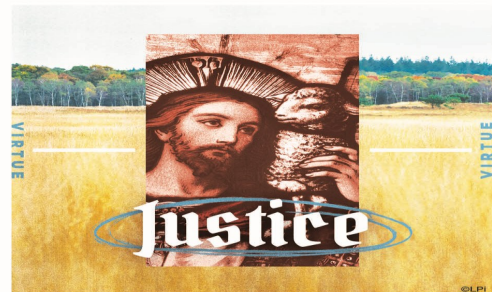
