PASTOR'S COLUMN:

Three weekends in a row.

MOTHER'S DAY, THE FEASTS OF THE ASCENSION, THE FEAST OF PENTECOST!

We take this weekend to thank and honor our mothers, living and deceased, for all they did for us.

The Feast of the Ascension, in most of our country, has been moved from Thursday May 14th to Sunday May 17th and so, May 14th is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation.

The Feast of Pentecost will be celebrated on Sunday May 24.

In the forty days between His Resurrection and His Ascension to Heaven, Jesus is—so to speak—weaning His disciples. He's helping them realize that He's not going to be with them in the same way anymore. He will be with them: He'll be with them always, "unto the end of the age." But He will not be with them physically as He was during the three years of His public ministry. He will not be at their sides to point the way or for them to talk with face-to-face.

Yet God the Holy Spirit will make Jesus Christ present in a new way. In a sense, that's what the Easter Season is designed by God to lead us to. Pentecost Sunday is not just the fiftieth of fifty days celebrating Jesus' Resurrection. Pentecost is the culmination of the Season of Easter. As such, Pentecost is the celebration of God the Holy Spirit making Jesus present in this world in a new way: that is, the Church.

This is one reason why the Church calls all of us—her children—together on the Lord's Day: not only to be united with God through Holy Communion, but also to be united more strongly with each other. The Mass—like the whole Christian life—is not just about me and Jesus. The Mass is the greatest way that God has to unite us poor, fallen sinners into the one body of the Church. The Holy Spirit is the One who helps us see why and how this is.

COLUMNA DEL PASTOR :

Tres fines de semana consecutivos.

¡El Día de la Madre, la Fiesta de la Ascensión y la Fiesta de Pentecostés!

Dedicamos este fin de semana a agradecer y honrar a nuestras madres —tanto a las vivas como a las difuntas— por todo lo que hicieron por nosotros.

La Fiesta de Pentecostés se celebrará el domingo 24 de mayo.

Durante los cuarenta días transcurridos entre su Resurrección y su Ascensión al Cielo, Jesús está —por así decirlo— destetando a sus discípulos. Les está ayudando a comprender que ya no estará con ellos de la misma manera. Estará con ellos: estará con ellos siempre, «hasta el fin de los tiempos». Pero no estará con ellos físicamente, como lo estuvo durante los tres años de su ministerio público. No estará a su lado para indicarles el camino ni para que puedan hablar con Él cara a cara.

Sin embargo, Dios el Espíritu Santo hará presente a Jesucristo de una manera nueva. En cierto sentido, eso es a lo que Dios ha diseñado que nos conduzca el Tiempo Pascual. El Domingo de Pentecostés no es simplemente el quincuagésimo de los cincuenta días de celebración de la Resurrección de Jesús. Pentecostés es la culminación del Tiempo Pascual. Como tal, Pentecostés es la celebración de que Dios el Espíritu Santo hace presente a Jesús en este mundo de una manera nueva: es decir, la Iglesia.

Esta es una de las razones por las que la Iglesia nos convoca a todos —sus hijos— en el Día del Señor: no solo para unirnos a Dios a través de la Sagrada Comunión, sino también para unirnos más fuertemente entre nosotros. La Misa —al igual que toda la vida cristiana— no trata únicamente sobre mí y Jesús. La Misa es el medio supremo que Dios tiene para unirnos a nosotros, pecadores pobres y caídos, en el único cuerpo de la Iglesia. El Espíritu Santo es quien nos ayuda a comprender por qué y cómo sucede esto.
