**PASTOR'S COLUMN:**

The Bible tells us that Jesus traveled all around the countryside. He went to many different towns and villages, and everywhere he went he saw crowds of people who were lost and helpless. It broke his heart. One day, he turned to his followers and said to them, "There are so many who need help, but there are not enough who are willing to help them. Get on your knees and pray that the Lord will send workers to help them." Sharing the Good News was so important to Jesus, and he wanted to make sure that everyone had a chance to hear it. When they had finished praying, Jesus called twelve of his followers to come to him. "Go," he said, "heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons." And he added, "As you go, preach this message: 'The kingdom of heaven is near.'"

Jesus sent out the twelve, and they went out to do what Jesus asked them to do. They went from town to town, healing people and sharing the Good News. They didn't have newspapers or the internet to help them spread the word, but they had something even better – the power of God working through them. They were able to do amazing things because they believed in Jesus and trusted him to guide them.

As they traveled, they met many people who were curious about Jesus and his message. They told stories of how Jesus had changed their lives and how he could change the lives of others too. They talked about how Jesus was a friend to everyone, no matter who they were or where they came from. They shared the Good News that God loved them and wanted them to be part of his family.

As the disciples continued their journey, they saw more and more people come to believe in Jesus. They saw lives changed and hearts filled with love. They knew that they were making a difference in the world by Sharing the Good News, and it filled them with joy.

Jesus sends out the twelve, and he sends out each of us too. We have a special job to do, and it's up to us to make sure that everyone has a chance to hear the Good News. It might not always be easy, but with Jesus by our side, we can make a difference in the world.



**COLUMNA DEL PASTOR :**

La Biblia nos dice que Jesús recorría toda la región. Visitaba muchas ciudades y aldeas, y dondequiera que iba veía multitudes de personas que estaban perdidas y desamparadas. Aquello le partía el corazón. Un día, se volvió hacia sus seguidores y les dijo: «Hay muchos que necesitan ayuda, pero no hay suficientes personas dispuestas a ayudarlos. Pónganse de rodillas y oren para que el Señor envíe obreros que los ayuden». Compartir las Buenas Nuevas era algo muy importante para Jesús, y él quería asegurarse de que todos tuvieran la oportunidad de escucharlas.
