**PASTOR'S COLUMN:**

St Paul's letter to the Corinthians gives us the oldest extant account of the institution of the Eucharist. Paul writes barely twenty years after the crucifixion; but he makes it clear – using the technical language of the rabbinical tradition in which he was formed – that he is handing on an authentic and sacred tradition of the Christian community. This is independently confirmed by the fact that Paul's narrative of what happened at the Last Supper shows clear evidence of having been modified by repetition in liturgical celebrations. The implications of Paul's brief account are momentous. 'This is my body, which is for you'. In the Church's central act of worship, Jesus makes himself the nourishment of the world, perpetuating the last act of his earthly life – in which he gave himself into the hands of his Father, for the life of the world. The words, 'This is the new covenant in my blood', echo the declaration of Moses as he inaugurated the first covenant (Exodus 24:8); but this is the 'new' covenant in which humanity's final bonding with God replaces the shadows and types of the Old Testament. The celebration is a 'memorial' that 'proclaims the Lord's death until he comes' – the constant faith of the Church since the beginning, that the Lord and his Paschal Mystery are present in the celebration of the Eucharist, finds strong support in the biblical overtones of these words.

We're excited to welcome new families to our St. Theresa community! Applications are now being accepted for Preschool (ages 3-4) thru 7th grade.

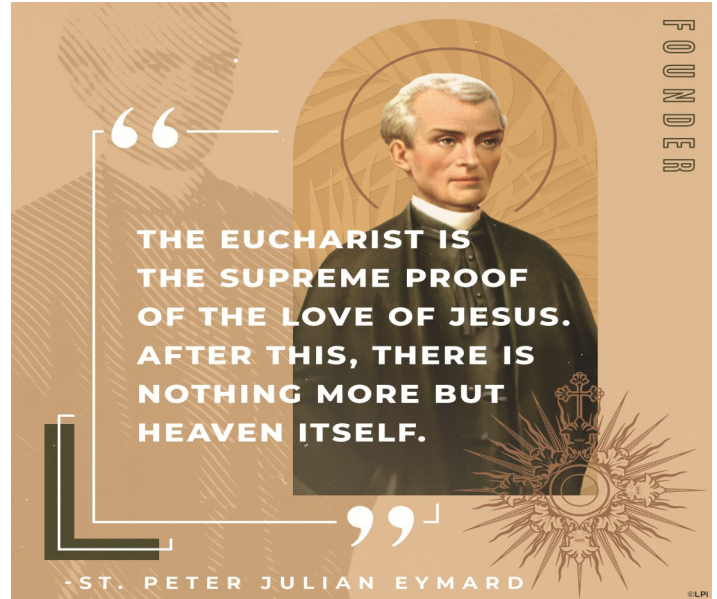

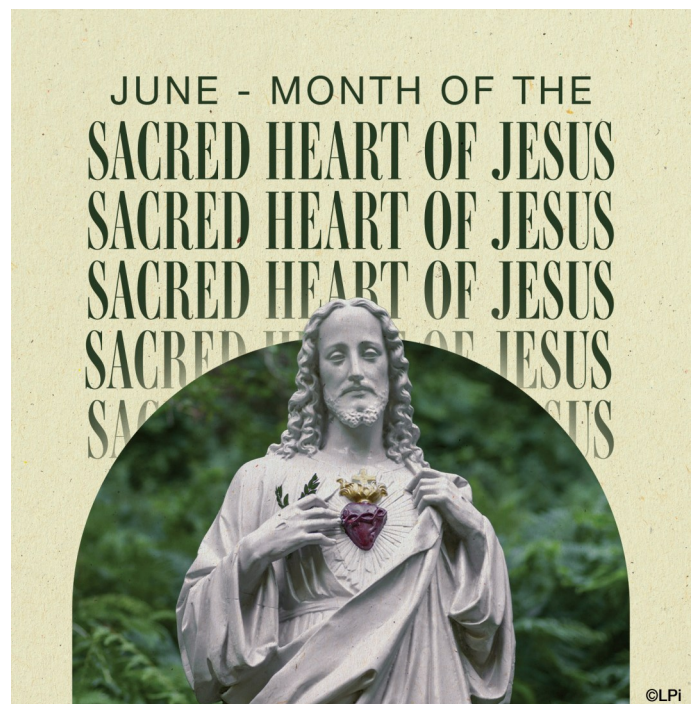


#### **Prayer for the True Presence**

## **COLUMNA DEL PASTOR:**

La carta de San Pablo a los Corintios nos ofrece el relato más antiguo que se conserva sobre la institución de la Eucaristía. Pablo escribe apenas veinte años después de la crucifixión; pero deja claro, utilizando el lenguaje técnico de la tradición rabínica en la que se formó, que transmite una tradición auténtica y sagrada de la comunidad cristiana. Esto se confirma independientemente por el hecho de que la narración de Pablo sobre lo sucedido en la Última Cena muestra claras evidencias de haber sido modificada por la repetición en las celebraciones litúrgicas. Las implicaciones del breve relato de Pablo son trascendentales. «Este es mi cuerpo, que se entrega por vosotros». En el acto central de culto de la Iglesia, Jesús se convierte en el alimento del mundo, perpetuando el último acto de su vida terrena, en el que se entregó en las manos de su Padre, para la vida del mundo. Las palabras: «Esta es la nueva alianza en mi sangre», evocan la declaración de Moisés al inaugurar la primera alianza (Éxodo 24,8). Pero esta es la «nueva» alianza en la que la unión definitiva de la humanidad con Dios reemplaza las sombras y los símbolos del Antiguo Testamento. La celebración es un «memorial» que «anuncia la muerte del Señor hasta que venga»: la fe constante de la Iglesia desde sus inicios, en que el Señor y su Misterio Pascual están presentes en la celebración de la Eucaristía, encuentra un fuerte respaldo en las connotaciones bíblicas de estas palabras.

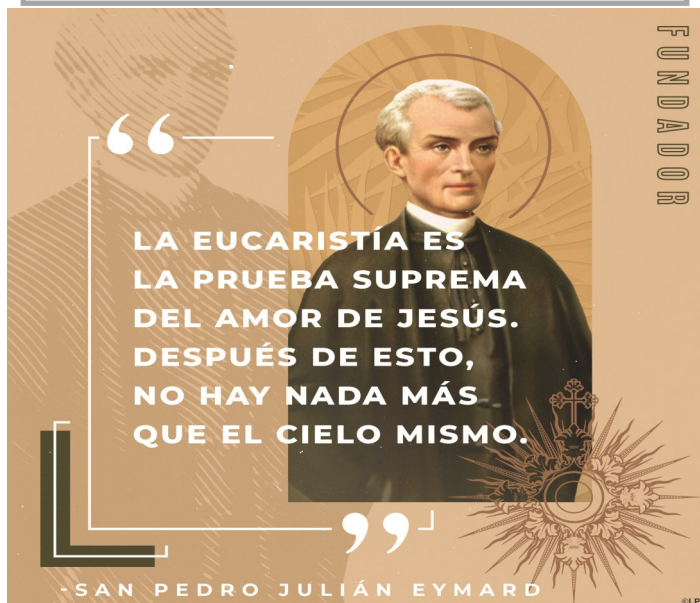
