PASTOR'S COLUMN:

Today, we might wonder: "And who is my neighbor?" (Lk 10:29). Jesus responds with the parable of the Good Samaritan.

To be a good Samaritan means we have to change our plans: "He approached the victim", dedicating our time: "poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them". This allows us to contemplate the figure of the innkeeper. Saint John Paul II pointed out: "What could the Samaritan have done without the innkeeper? In fact, the anonymous innkeeper is the one who takes care of the toughest part of the job. We can all act like him if we fulfill our own task with a spirit of service to others. Every occupation offers the more or less direct possibility to help the needy. The faithful accomplishment of our own professional duties already implies the practice of our loving all persons, as well as our society."

Jesus could have also responded to "and who is my neighbor" with the parable in Matthew 25:31-46; the judgement of the sheep and the goats.

"For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, a stranger and you gave me no welcome, naked and you gave me no clothing, ill and in prison, and you did not care for me."

Then they will answer and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill or in prison, and not minister to your needs?'

He will answer them, 'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.'

And these will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."
Salvation does not come through quoting bible verses but by living and acting on them in our life!

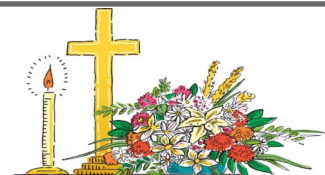

COLUMNA DEL PASTOR :

Hoy podríamos preguntarnos: "¿Y quién es mi prójimo?" (Lc 10,29). Jesús responde con la parábola del Buen Samaritano.

Ser un buen samaritano implica cambiar de planes: «Se acercó a la víctima», dedicando nuestro tiempo: «derramó aceite y vino sobre sus heridas y las vendó». Esto nos permite contemplar la figura del posadero. San Juan Pablo II señaló: «¿Qué habría hecho el samaritano sin el posadero? De hecho, el posadero anónimo es quien se encarga de la parte más difícil del trabajo. Todos podemos actuar como él si cumplimos nuestra tarea con espíritu de servicio a los demás. Toda ocupación ofrece la posibilidad, más o menos directa, de ayudar a los necesitados. El fiel cumplimiento de nuestros deberes profesionales ya implica la práctica de amar a todas las personas, así como a nuestra sociedad».

Jesús también podría haber respondido a “¿y quién es mi prójimo?” con la parábola de Mateo 25:31-46; el juicio de las ovejas y las cabras.

“Porque tuve hambre, y no me disteis de comer; tuve sed, y no me disteis de beber; fui forastero, y no me hospedasteis; estuve desnudo, y no me vestisteis; enfermo, y en la cárcel, y no me visitasteis.”

Entonces le responderán: «Señor, ¿cuándo te vimos hambriento o sediento o forastero o desnudo o enfermo o en la cárcel, y no te asistimos?»

Él les responderá: «En verdad les digo que lo que no hicieron con uno de estos pequeños, tampoco conmigo lo hicieron.»

Y estos irán al castigo eterno, pero los justos a la vida eterna.

¡La salvación no se consigue citando versículos bíblicos, sino viviendo y actuando conforme a ellos!
