PASTOR'S COLUMN:

A man prayed for months for his dream job. Finally, he got the interview. Nervously, he prayed, "God, please let me get this job!" The next morning, he got a rejection email. He sighed and complained, "God, I asked for this job!" A voice replied, "I'm working on the promotion for next week. Patience!"

Our relationship with God is not unlike that of children who expect their parents to respond positively to every request they have. The important thing for all concerned is to maintain a loving and trusting contact, (with our parent and our God) in spite of occasional bumps in the road. Today's parable reminds us that this. The lesson of the parable is concerned, therefore, with our experience of the reality and presence of God in our lives. It is faith alone that enables us to experience God as One who is exceedingly good and who loves us very much. We will want to persist in our prayers to him, not just because we need his help, but primarily because we want simply to stay in touch with this wonderful Person, who loves us unconditionally. In the long run, this loving God will give us all that we need...and much more.

On a trip home, many years ago, my mother was complaining about all the items she received in the mail asking her to contribute; an inexpensive string rosary, a plastic teepee, labels with her "return address" printed on them. I told mom not to feel obligated even if they "sent her something". She should decide what charities she wanted to support. I suggested her home parish, the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart (the religious community Fr. David, Lomano and I belong to), and maybe a group that fights Cancer, the disease that my father died from.

I bring this up because these past few weeks it looks like we are having a "second collection" every week. Actually, most of these extra collections are diocesan requested. The first or main collection is for the support of your parish. It enables us to pay our bills (like the \$ 8,000.00 electric/air conditioning bill we received for last month). The only extra parish collection is taken up the first weekend of the month and that is for the parish school and religious education programs.

And so I tell you what I told my mother many years ago; do not to feel obligated to give to every second collection. You decide what you want to contribute to. IF, the Good Lord has blessed you with a few extra bucks after supporting your parish, please do what you can to assist these needs of your local and worldwide church. And thank you very much for your generosity!.....Fr. John P. Kavcak, M.S.C.

COLUMNA DEL PASTOR :

Un hombre oró durante meses por el trabajo de sus sueños. Finalmente, consiguió la entrevista. Nervioso, oró: "¡Dios, por favor, déjame conseguir este trabajo!". A la mañana siguiente, recibió un correo electrónico de rechazo. Suspiró y se quejó: "¡Dios, yo pedí este trabajo!". Una voz le respondió: "Estoy trabajando en el ascenso para la próxima semana. ¡Paciencia!".

Nuestra relación con Dios no es diferente a la de los hijos que esperan que sus padres respondan positivamente a cada petición que tienen. Lo importante para todos es mantener un contacto amoroso y de confianza (con nuestros padres y con nuestro Dios) a pesar de los ocasionales obstáculos. La parábola de hoy nos lo recuerda. La lección de la parábola se centra, por lo tanto, en nuestra experiencia de la realidad y la presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas. Solo la fe nos permite experimentar a Dios como Aquel que es sumamente bueno y que nos ama profundamente. Querremos persistir en nuestras oraciones, no solo porque necesitamos su ayuda, sino principalmente porque simplemente queremos mantenernos en contacto con esta maravillosa Persona, que nos ama incondicionalmente. A la larga, este Dios amoroso nos dará todo lo que necesitamos... y mucho más.

Hace muchos años, durante un viaje a casa, mi madre se quejaba de todos los artículos que recibía por correo pidiéndole que contribuyera: un rosario de cuerda barato, un tipi de plástico, etiquetas con su "dirección del remitente" impresa. Le dije que no se sintiera obligada, aunque le "enviaran algo". Que decidiera a qué organizaciones benéficas quería apoyar. Le sugerí su parroquia, los Misioneros del Sagrado Corazón (la comunidad religiosa a la que pertenecemos el padre David, Lomano y yo), y tal vez un grupo de lucha contra el cáncer, la enfermedad de la que murió mi padre.

Menciono esto porque, en las últimas semanas, parece que estamos haciendo una "segunda colecta" cada semana. De hecho, la mayoría de estas colectas adicionales son solicitadas por la diócesis. La primera colecta, o la principal, es para el apoyo de su parroquia. Nos permite pagar nuestras facturas (como la factura de \$8,000.00 de electricidad y aire acondicionado que recibimos el mes pasado). La única colecta parroquial adicional se realiza el primer fin de semana del mes y es para la escuela parroquial y los programas de educación religiosa.

Así que les digo lo que le dije a mi madre hace muchos años: no se sientan obligados a donar en cada segunda colecta. Ustedes deciden a qué quieren contribuir. Si Dios los ha bendecido con unos dólares extra después de apoyar a su parroquia, por favor, hagan lo que puedan para ayudar a estas necesidades de su iglesia local y mundial. ¡Y muchas gracias por su generosidad!..... Saint Theresa Parish Financial Comments – October 1, 2025

The annual Statements of Operating Income and Expenses for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2023, 2024 and 2025 are summarized on the following page. Restricted income received for major repairs and replacement of components of the Parish property is not included in the Operating Revenue. Expenditures for major repairs and replacements of Parish property is not included in the expenses. This is in order to separately track the ongoing daily income and expenses of the Parish. The Parish had operating net income for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 of \$14,697. The Parish had net operating losses of \$10,659 and \$14,349 respectively, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2024 and June 30, 2025. Contributions and Donations for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2025 decreased by \$48,485 (5.8 percent) compared to the prior fiscal year. This is a trend that needs to be addressed this fiscal year.

Also on the following page is a Comparative Statement of Financial Position for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2024 and June 30, 2025. Monthly updates for the current fiscal year will be included in this section of the newly expanded bulletin by the end of October.

The final empty position in the Parish office will be filled before the end of October. We will once again be fully staffed for the upcoming winter season. Bingo on Fridays is anticipated to begin again in November. Proceeds from the Bingo sessions will be donated to Saint Theresa School.

By the end of this month we will be producing a monthly accounting of the restricted revenue received from the activities of the 135 Ministry and the Columbarium Niche sales. We will also report monthly major repair and replacement expenditures paid for with these restricted revenues. We will also be reporting anticipated future major repairs and replacements. We know that we have over two million dollars in anticipated major repairs and replacements in the next three to ten years. We need the Columbarium to start producing a steady cash flow, augmented by the 135 Ministry's efforts, in order to have the funds to cover these anticipated expenditures. Please refer to the new financial information pages in the weekly Parish Bulletins for monthly updates on this activity. We want all Parishioners to be as fully financial informed as possible.

Qualified Charitable Distributions / IRA Rollover

You can make a donation to the Parish directly from your IRA. This type of donation is known as a "qualified charitable distribution". This allows individuals age 70 and ½ or older to authorize their IRA administrator to directly transfer up to \$100,000 annually from their IRA to the Parish, tax free. If you are age 73 or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution. Please contact your income tax professional.

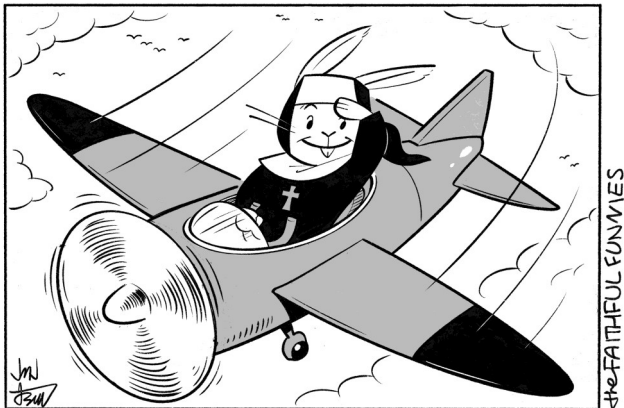
