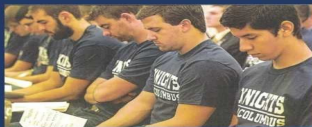


What is this Ministry about?

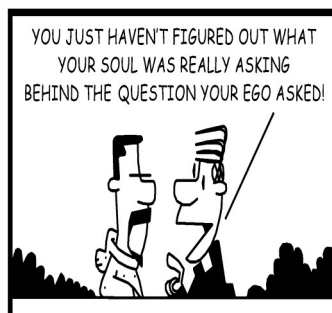
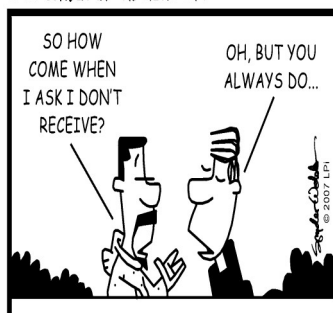
