**Pastor's column:**

We delve deep into the teaching of Christ on discipleship and the project of building the Church, which for us, is the Kingdom of God. When two or more people come together, there is a lot of chance for difference of opinion and disagreements which is normal, but unity and reconciliation bring joy and celebration. This teaching of Jesus helps us a great deal, because - let us consider an example — when we see a mistake, a fault, a slip, in that brother or sister, usually the first thing we do is to go and recount it to others, to gossip. And gossip closes the heart to the community, closes off the unity of the Church. The great gossip is the devil, who always goes about saying bad things about others, because he is the liar who seeks to separate the Church to distance brothers and sisters and not create community. Please, brothers and sisters, let us make an effort not to gossip. Gossip is a plague more awful than Covid! Let us make an effort: no gossip. It is the love of Jesus, who had embraced the tax collectors and Gentiles, scandalizing the conformists of the time. However it is not a sentence without an appeal, but a recognition that at times our human attempts may fail, and that only being before God can bring the brother to face his own conscience and responsibility for his actions. If this matter does not work, then silence and prayer for the brother or sister who has made a mistake, but never gossip. (Pope Francis). Our Parish is blessed with more than Twenty different committees and groups working together as one parish family. Let us encourage each other in our ministries and avoid comments that can bring division among us and forgive and seek reconciliation when relationships are strained. Please keep in me your prayers as we begin to establish a new parish pastoral council to help us achieve the mission and vision of the parish. The greatest gift that Jesus imparts to the Church is Unity, and that unity bring Peace with the Grace of the Holy Spirit.

Christ tells us that “where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them.” Our faith compels us to be in community with one another. No one should be a Christian alone. How can you draw closer to others who love Christ?

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**COLUMNA DEL PASTOR :**

Profundizamos en las enseñanzas de Cristo sobre el discipulado y el proyecto de edificar la Iglesia, que para nosotros es el Reino de Dios. Cuando dos o más personas se reúnen, es muy probable que surjan diferencias de opinión y desacuerdos —lo cual es normal—, pero la unidad y la reconciliación traen alegría y celebración. Esta enseñanza de Jesús nos ayuda enormemente porque —pongamos un ejemplo— cuando vemos un error, una falta o un tropiezo en un hermano o hermana, lo primero que solemos hacer es ir a contárselo a otros, a chismorrear. Y el chisme cierra el corazón a la comunidad y obstaculiza la unidad de la Iglesia. El gran chismoso es el diablo, que siempre anda diciendo cosas malas de los demás, pues es el mentiroso que busca dividir a la Iglesia, distanciar a los hermanos y hermanas e impedir la creación de comunidad. Por favor, hermanos y hermanas, esforcémonos por no caer en el chisme. ¡El chisme es una plaga peor que el Covid! Hagamos el esfuerzo: nada de chismes. Es el amor de Jesús, quien acogió a publicanos y gentiles, escandalizando a los conformistas de la época. Sin embargo, no se trata de una sentencia inapelable, sino del reconocimiento de que, a veces, nuestros intentos humanos pueden fracasar, y de que solo el estar ante Dios puede llevar al hermano a confrontar su propia conciencia y la responsabilidad de sus actos. Si esto no funciona, entonces silencio y oración por el hermano o hermana que ha cometido el error, pero nunca chismes. (Papa Francisco). Nuestra parroquia tiene la bendición de contar con más de veinte comités y grupos diferentes que trabajan unidos como una sola familia parroquial. Animémonos mutuamente en nuestros ministerios, evitemos comentarios que puedan generar división entre nosotros y busquemos el perdón y la reconciliación cuando las relaciones se tensen. Por favor, ténganme presente en sus oraciones mientras comenzamos a establecer un nuevo consejo pastoral parroquial que nos ayude a alcanzar la misión y la visión de la parroquia. El mayor don que Jesús otorga a la Iglesia es la unidad, y esa unidad trae la paz mediante la gracia del Espíritu Santo.
