**PASTOR'S COLUMN:**

In Luke's account of the life of Jesus, we are at a turning point. Jesus is beginning his journey to Jerusalem to meet his fate; and he is instructing the followers who must carry on his mission. He has already sent his chosen twelve out on mission. Now he sends out 'seventy-two others. The numbers are symbolic. The mission of the apostles is to the twelve tribes of Israel – since the immediate concern of Jesus was to call the nation back to faithfulness. Seventy-two was the number of the pagan nations, according to the traditions of the Old Testament – ultimately the mission of Jesus is universal.

The 'seventy-two others' represent all of us, his followers in every age, called to share in his mission to bring the Good News of God to all people.

'Evangelization', being bearers of the Good News, is a basic theme in the Church's teaching today. 'The laborers are few', Jesus tells us, and we tend to think he is referring to the 'professionals', clergy and religious. But today's gospel tells us that it is that not only those who carry on a leadership role like that of the apostles, but all followers of Jesus who are called to carry forward the Church's mission in the name of Christ.

En el relato de Lucas sobre la vida de Jesús, nos encontramos en un punto de inflexión. Jesús emprende su viaje a Jerusalén para enfrentar su destino e instruye a los seguidores que deben continuar su misión. Ya ha enviado a sus doce elegidos en misión. Ahora envía a otros setenta y dos. Los números son simbólicos. La misión de los apóstoles es para las doce tribus de Israel, ya que la preocupación inmediata de Jesús era llamar a la nación a la fidelidad. Setenta y dos era el número de las naciones paganas, según las tradiciones del Antiguo Testamento; en definitiva, la misión de Jesús es universal.

Los «setenta y dos» nos representan a todos nosotros, sus seguidores de todos los tiempos, llamados a compartir su misión de llevar la Buena Nueva de Dios a todas las personas. La «evangelización», ser portadores de la Buena Nueva, es un tema fundamental en la enseñanza de la Iglesia actual. «Los obreros son pocos», nos dice Jesús, y solemos pensar que se refiere a los «profesionales», el clero y los religiosos. Pero el evangelio de hoy nos dice que no solo quienes ejercen un liderazgo como el de los apóstoles, sino todos los seguidores de Jesús están llamados a llevar adelante la misión de la Iglesia en nombre de Cristo.
