GLOBAL REACH, LOCAL CARE


We form connections with parents, physicians, educators, and advocates who know this journey because we've walked it ourselves.

2025 AT A GLANCE

In just over three years, with significant momentum in 2025, *Team Iron Will* has:

- Supported 3,926 families in 37 countries
- Delivered 374 pieces of life-changing equipment and family resources
- Granted 141 therapy scholarships
- Reached over 123 million people online with stories of dignity and hope

2025 marked continued growth in both scale and depth of impact. *Team Iron Will* expanded its reach while remaining rooted in personal, family-centered care.




MEDICAL, THERAPEUTIC, AND ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT ITEMS AND CARE PACKAGES




EDUCATIONAL AND ADVOCACY TRAINING SESSIONS

Team Iron Will has hosted **23** educational and advocacy training sessions since 2023.





STORIES THAT SHAPED 2025

One family shared that when they received their child's Down syndrome diagnosis, they were uncertain whether they could continue the pregnancy. Encountering Will's story – shared through *Team Iron Will* – changed everything. That glimpse of possibility gave them courage. Today, their child is thriving and deeply loved.

Stories like this defined 2025. Through millions of online engagements and thousands of direct interactions, families encountered truth, hope, and community at the moment they needed it most.

Storytelling is not supplemental to our mission – it is lifesaving.

"My son Lucas has had a whirlwind of a year after a leukemia diagnosis with major complications in the beginning.

I stopped teaching music to stay home with the kids, take Lucas to appointments, and protect him from germs while he goes through chemotherapy. We are now living on one teacher salary and our GoFundMe to pay the bills.

Lucas is now 3 and a half, is starting preschool in person, and on maintenance chemo! One area where he continues to struggle is speech. Because of the *Team Iron Will* scholarship program we were able to take a 6-week speech course for free."




PROGRAMS, EVENTS, AND ACHIEVEMENTS



BUILDING FOR GREATER IMPACT

In 2025, *Team Iron Will* worked with *Life On Belay* to complete a comprehensive organizational assessment and rebrand to better equip our organization to advocate for individuals with Down syndrome and the families we serve, unveiling a new visual identity and a fully redesigned, community-focused website. Our new minimalist "phoenix in flight" logo – featured in the prestigious *LogoLounge 2025 Logo Trend Report* – symbolizes hope, resilience, and overcoming adversity.

2025 FALL CLASSIC WIFFLE BALL TOURNAMENT AND DOWN SYNDROME ADVOCACY EVENT:



On September 22, 2025, *Team Iron Will* hosted our first annual *Fall Classic Wiffle Ball Tournament and Down Syndrome Advocacy Event*. With 15 teams from around the country, more than 200 participants, 13 generous sponsors, great food, meaningful conversations, and cooperative weather, it was truly a special day. We can't wait to take it to the next level in 2026!

CHAMPION POSSIBILITY CAMPAIGN:



In 2025, *Team Iron Will* launched the *Champion Possibility* campaign to encourage a shift in how individuals with Down syndrome are seen, supported, and celebrated. Through storytelling, community engagement, and advocacy, the campaign calls others to choose hope over fear, see possibility instead of limitations, celebrate every victory – no matter how small – and actively support individuals with Down syndrome as they pursue full, meaningful lives. At its heart, *Champion Possibility* is about standing alongside individuals and families, cheering them on every step of the way.

PROGRAMS, EVENTS, AND ACHIEVEMENTS (CONTINUED)

DOWN SYNDROME MEDICAL ADVOCACY PROJECT:

In 2025, *Team Iron Will* launched the *Down Syndrome Medical Advocacy Project*, initiating targeted outreach and relationship-building with medical providers as the first step toward establishing a nationwide network committed to care that honors every child's worth and potential.

TEAM IRON WILL "DATE NIGHT FOR GOOD":

On August 22, *Team Iron Will* hosted our first "Date Night for Good," bringing supporters together in person and virtually for an intimate evening of connection, storytelling, and advocacy. Together, we reflected on our journey, celebrated the impact already made, and shared our vision for the future.

SHARING OUR STORY

In 2025, *Team Iron Will*'s mission and advocacy efforts were highlighted in national publications including *The Epoch Times*, *Catholic World Report*, *Live Action News*, and the *EveryLife Blog*, and through podcast appearances on *Conquering Your Clownfish* and *Combat Christian*.

COLLABORATIVE RELATIONSHIPS

Team Iron Will believes meaningful impact is achieved through teamwork. 


FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

Team Iron Will is committed to responsible stewardship and transparency. The resources entrusted to our organization are used to maximize direct family impact while ensuring long-term sustainability and accountability.

In 2025, the majority of *Team Iron Will*'s resources were directed toward community support programs that directly serve families and advance advocacy efforts, including:

- Providing adaptive and therapeutic equipment
- Therapy scholarships and educational sessions
- Outreach and family support initiatives
- Medical advocacy and provider network development
- Operational infrastructure necessary to responsibly scale impact

2025 REVENUE





LOOKING AHEAD TO 2026



Globally, more than 1.6 million individuals live with Down syndrome. While *Team Iron Will* has already served thousands of families, the need continues to grow. Looking ahead, *Team Iron Will* remains focused on thoughtful growth that expands impact while staying rooted in principle and relationships.

In 2026, our priorities include:

- **Serving 400+ additional families** through therapy support, adaptive equipment, and educational resources
- **Expanding the Down Syndrome Medical Advocacy Project** to 150-200 trusted providers, while working to inform and inspire healthcare professionals who are committed to learning but may not yet fully understand the strengths, potential, and unique medical considerations of people with Down syndrome
- **Growing the Champion Possibility campaign** to include self-advocacy through a bench of inspirational speakers living and thriving with Down syndrome
- **Assisting in the development and advancement of legislative efforts** focused on nondiscrimination and personhood
- **Strengthening global outreach** while preserving the relational, family-centered care that defines our work

Every future goal is tied to a life improved, a family strengthened, and a culture changed.

Team Iron Will is guided by a dedicated team and board of directors committed to faithful stewardship, accountability, and mission-aligned leadership.
