TOLEDO HOSPITAL | RUSSELL J. EBEID CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL



"I want to be someone who cares about people. It's important to me to give back to area hospitals because [children born with Congenital Heart Disease] are stuck in the hospital fighting the same battle I'm fighting. I know what that feels like and how overwhelming it can be when everything is going on and you don't understand it." Caden Laney Caden was born with a Bicuspid Aortic Valve, a Congenital Heart Defect (CHD) that causes Aortic Valve Stenosis. A normal aortic valve has three leaflets that form a gateway from the heart to the rest of the body. Caden's bicuspid aortic valve was stenotic or tight and restricted blood flow exiting his heart. Caden has spent much of his childhood in and out of the hospital working to correct his CHD. in September of 2015 Caden was able to successfully undergo an open-heart surgery to replace his aortic valve with his normally formed pulmonary valve and he was blessed to receive a cadaver valve in his pulmonary position. This operation, known as a Ross Procedure, corrected Caden's Aortic Valve Stenosis. Caden's battle with CHD is far from over as he continues to require frequent monitoring and will likely need further corrective surgery to repair his Aortia again in adulthood. Although Caden's journey with CHD has not been easy he remains positive and determined to support and inspire other children like him. In 2019, when Caden's mom asked what he wanted for Christmas, Caden responded saying he "wants to donate his gifts to children spending the holidays at C.S. Mott Children's Hospital." Caden did just that! Caden's passion for this toy drive and his mission to spread joy through it has only grown stronger over the past 7 years. In 2023 Caden underwent Valve Sparing Aortic Root replacement and a total replacement of Pulmonary valve, his second open heart surgery to further correct his CHD. And while Caden received the all clear he knows that CHD is still a life long journey and this toy drive is his way of helping those that are in the same position as he once was.
