## PREPPING FOR THE PROCEDURE

Before the procedure, you may need to fast overnight and discuss any medications you are taking with Dr. Carson or staff.




#### **DURING THE PROCEDURE**

During the procedure, you will be given sedation and a local anesthetic to numb the area. Our radiologist inserts a thin catheter through a small incision in the groin and guides it to the uterine arteries that supply blood to the fibroids. Once the catheter is in place, small particles are injected to block the blood flow to the fibroids, causing them to shrink and die off.



#### PROCEDURE AFTERCARE

After the procedure, you may experience cramping very similar to labor pains.
Recovery assistance is available at all times from Dr. Carson and staff.



## AN EFFECTIVE ALTERNATIVE TO SURGICAL PROCEDURES FOR UTERINE FIBROIDS!

A UFE is a <u>minimally invasive</u> procedure that involves only a <u>small incision</u> in the groin, allowing for a <u>shorter and less</u> <u>painful recovery time</u> along with <u>reduced risk of complications</u>.
