OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

ARLA Ref: 62/OFF/02/21

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Ri Ra Events Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at 21 Dolma Street METHVEN and known as "The Sheebeen" to any person for consumption off the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

ENDORSEMENT (Remote sellers of alcohol)

Section 40 of the Act applies to this, the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

CONDITIONS - SECTION 116 (1-2)

- (a) No alcohol may be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on ANZAC Day.
- (b) Alcohol may only be sold or delivered on the following days and during the following hours

Monday - Sunday; 11.00am - 9.00pm

- (c) An exemption from the trading hours restrictions for remote sale of alcohol applies and may be made at any time on any day.
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (e) The whole of the premise is Undesignated

Conditions applying to all remote sales for sale and supply of Alcohol

- a) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the license holder and on every receipt used for any alcohol sold via the internet site
 - i) The licence holders name, the licence number, and the date on which the licence expires
- b) A copy of the licence or a clearly identified link to such an image must be displayed in a prominent place on the internet site
- c) The following steps must be taken to verify that buyers are over the purchase age
 - i) In the case of an order made using the internet site, telephone order, or physical order, the prospective buyer must declare that he or she is 18 years of age or over (and where a prospective buyer is involved that the prospective receiver is also 18 years or over)
 - ii) Once, the prospective buyer first commences the order process: and
 - iii) Again, immediately before the sale of alcohol is completed.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either -
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises are identified as 21 Dolma Street (The Sheebeen's usual location when not on hire).
