Congratulations on your upcoming graduation! The Pershing Park Baptist Church members would like to award a \$200 gift to each graduating high school student who fills out the following Graduation Gift packet.

Additionally, one deserving graduate can be awarded a \$500 scholarship to be paid to the higher education institute of the awardee's choice. All you must do is apply for the scholarship.

Each graduate must submit their completed package to the church administrator **no later than April 30.**

You can apply for both the scholarship and monetary gift or just the monetary gift.

The information provided by the applicant will be held in the strictest confidence and will be shared only with those persons directly involved with the scholarship selection process.

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The deadline is April 30. The office is open Sunday during church and Monday-Thursday 9 AM-12 PM. Make arrangements to get your packet in on time.

Each application will be reviewed by a three (3) board panel composed of a president with no vote and three (3) voting members of the scholarship committee (not related to the applicant.) We welcome all applications and will base our selection on the following criteria:

- Applicant must have been accepted to an accredited school.
- Applicant must be an active member of the Pershing Park Baptist Church
- Applicant must be a graduating senior from an area high school
- Applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5
- Applicant must provide three letters of recommendation with the application with a minimum of one from a Pershing Park Church member.
- Applicant must provide a current high school transcript
- Applicant must submit an essay on a specific topic
- Applicants must provide a photo of them participating in church activity.

FAQs and More Information:

➤ **The scholarship will only be paid out upon receipt of proof of enrollment.**

➤ Letters of recommendation

1. High School of Attendance (teacher, counselor, coach, etc.)
2. Ministry of 'The Park' in which you are an active participant (youth, choir, usher, dance, etc.)
3. Person of choice (school, community leader, member of 'The Park', etc.)

NOTE: No more than two letters may be from 'The Park' members. Letters from the pastor, first lady, or selection committee **will not** be accepted.

- Current transcript (an unofficial copy will be accepted) or proof of completion of Home School are acceptable.
- Proof of Academic Honors and School Involvement, Community Involvement, and Achievements/ Training can be in the form of certificates, photos, letters, etc.
