We are called not to rush one another through pain, but to walk together with patience, prayer, and compassion. Sometimes the holiest thing we can do is sit beside one another and trust God to do the healing work in His time.

As we move through these winter weeks and step into a new year, let us be intentional about checking on one another, offering a kind word, a listening ear, or a simple prayer. Let us also give ourselves permission to rest. Winter is not a failure of faith; it is a necessary pause. Even the earth rests before spring.

May this new year be less about resolutions and more about renewal. Renewed trust, renewed hope, and renewed reliance on God's grace. Endings are not the same as abandonment, and stillness is not the same as stagnation. God is at work even now, quietly shaping what comes next. And when the light returns, we will recognize it not as something rushed, but as something faithfully prepared.



## Lottie Moon, Missionary to China

Lottie Moon was a missionary to China. A missionary is someone who travels to another place to tell people about Jesus. Lottie went to China on a ship in 1873 to tell the Chinese people about Jesus.

At first, the Chinese people were afraid of Lottie. They called her a "foreign devil" because she didn't look like them and she came from a place they had never heard of. Lottie decided to bake cookies for the children. The children liked the cookies! Then, the mothers invited Lottie into their homes, and she told them about Jesus. The children called Lottie "the cookie lady."

Lottie also wrote lots of letters home to the United States. She wanted people to pray for the Chinese people. She also wanted more people to go to China to tell people about Jesus. Because of Lottie's letters, Southern Baptists began collecting an offering every year for international missions.

Lottie Moon died on Christmas Eve, 1912. Every year, Southern Baptist churches collect an offering to send Southern Baptist missionaries to countries around the world where they tell people about Jesus. The offering is called the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering®.

This year, the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering goal for Southern Baptists is \$175 million! That's a lot of money, but it helps support nearly 3,600 missionaries and their 2,880 children who are telling people about Jesus! Thank you for giving to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering!
