## **RE revised Long Term Plan (2024)**

We will be covering 5 units over the course of the year, giving each unit at least 7 weeks. RE is taught on a 2 year cycle. Over two years 50% of the curriculum will be taught from Understanding Christianity and 50% of the curriculum will be taught from The Emmanuel Project or thematic from a big question which will explore and compare different religions. Progression of knowledge has been carefully considered, and due to the nature of being a small school we recognise there might be gaps in the curriculum as not all children will get the same offer depending on their journey through classes in the school. To balance this, we deliberately and explicitly teach substantive knowledge in the summer term's Big Question unit so that children don't miss out. We are confident children cover disciplinary knowledge and skills as these are inherently planned into each unit.
