BAPTISM OF INFANTS

Baptisms of children under 7 years old are offered every fourth Sunday of each month in Spanish and every second Sunday of the month in English. Please visit our website or contact our office for details and requirements.

CONFIRMATION

At confirmation we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit and confirm and renew our baptismal promises committing to a life of maturity in the Christian faith. Unconfirmed Catholics wishing to receive the Sacrament should contact the Parish Office to make arrangements for suitable instruction. Unbaptized or non-Catholics can be confirmed at the Easter Vigil when they are baptized or received into the Church as a part of Order of Christian Initiation of Adult. To enroll in OCIA, please call Griselda Cisneros at 992-0901.

EUCHARIST

Parishioners who wish to bring communion to their spouses should contact the parish office to pick up a pyx with the St. Leo's inscription on it. Please use this pyx when approaching to receive a host for your spouse or a family member in the Communion procession during Mass. If you need to receive a gluten free host due to a medical condition please arrive 15 minutes before Mass begins and inform the Sacristan.

RECONCILIATION

Individual confession with a priest is the principal means of absolution and reconciliation of grave sins within the Church. The Sacrament of Reconciliation frees us from sinful patterns of behavior and calls us to complete conversion to Christ. Confessions are heard at 2pm on Saturday in English and 2pm on Sunday in Spanish in the Church. You may also approach any of our parish priests to hear your confession at another suitable time.

THE RITE OF ANOINTING

A person does not need to wait until the point of death to receive this sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after the anointing but becomes ill once again, or if, during the same illness, the person's condition becomes more serious. For those who are about to depart from this life, the Church offers the person Penance, Anointing of the Sick, and the Eucharist as Viaticum (food for the journey) given at the end of life. Contact the Parish Office at 992-0901 to be connected with the priest on duty.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are a registered parishioner of St. Leo and plan to marry in our parish please contact our office at least six months prior to the tentative wedding date. Weddings cannot be scheduled until the marriage preparation process is complete and it is determined that the parties are free to marry.

ANNULMENT - Reestablishing the freedom to marry.

An annulment is more accurately described as a declaration of matrimonial invalidity. It is an official determination made by an ecclesiastical court that at the time of the marital consent exchanged by the parties a specific component of the marriage was lacking or defective. Hence, the marriage failed to be a marriage as defined by the Catholic Church. If you wish to reestablish your freedom to marry in the Church, please contact a parish priest to be your advocate in presenting your case to the Tribunal.

Daily Reflections

by Father Jarek

Sunday, September 21, 2025

Who Owns My Heart “You cannot serve both God and mammon” (Luke 16:13)

Most of us have learned that money talks, but it also whispers. It tells us we never have enough, or that if we just had a little more, life would finally be easy. Jesus warns that the real danger is not in having money but in letting money have us. Amos points out how some people even cheated with scales to squeeze a few more coins. Today we do not carry scales in our pockets, but our hearts still tilt toward greed.

Paul urges us to pray for all leaders, even the ones who give us heartburn. Why? Because God wants every soul saved. If I spend more energy grumbling than praying, my heart is not free. Jesus says if we are faithful in small things, heaven will trust us with real treasure. That is a promise worth more than gold.

Prayer: Lord, free me from the grip of mammon. Teach me to be faithful in little things so I can rejoice in the riches of Your Kingdom. Amen.

Amos 8:4–7; Psalm 113; 1 Timothy 2:1–8; Luke 16:1–13

Monday, September 22, 2025

Light on a Lampstand “No one who lights a lamp conceals it” (Luke 8:16)

We know the power of light. You flip the switch in the middle of the night and suddenly the chair you nearly tripped over is no longer a threat. Jesus says faith should be like that. Do not hide it under the bed. Let it shine so others can walk without stumbling.

Even King Cyrus, a pagan ruler, was moved to rebuild God’s temple. If God can use him, He can certainly use me, even with my quirks and aches. We do not need to dazzle like stadium lights. A steady porch light that keeps shining through the years may be exactly what someone else needs.

Prayer: Father, help me to shine with steady kindness. May my life be a light that points others to You. Amen.

Ezra 1:1–6; Psalm 126; Luke 8:16–18

Tuesday, September 23, 2025

True Family “My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and act on it” (Luke 8:21)

Family is complicated. Some of us are blessed with Sunday dinners and laughter. Others know more about strained silence than joyful reunions. Jesus teaches that His family is made up of those who hear God’s word and live it. That means every pew becomes part of our family photo.

Ezra tells how the temple was rebuilt with joy. Families do that too. They build, they celebrate, and yes, sometimes they argue about the thermostat. Saint Pio reminds us that God’s family is not perfect, but it is held together by love stronger than blood. That is a family worth belonging to.

Prayer: Jesus, thank You for calling me family. Help me to listen to Your word and live it with love. Amen.

Wednesday, September 24, 2025

Traveling Light “Take nothing for the journey” (Luke 9:3)

Packing light is hard. Even for a weekend trip, most of us sneak in an extra shirt or two “just in case.” Jesus tells His disciples to travel without baggage. He wants them to learn that God’s provision is better than a stuffed suitcase.

Ezra admits the sins of the people and thanks God for mercy that gave them a second chance. That is what traveling light really looks like. Put down the guilt, the regrets, and the “what ifs.” Carry mercy instead. It is easier on the shoulders and brighter for the soul.

Prayer: Lord, help me set aside the baggage of shame and regret.

Let me walk light in Your mercy and free in Your mission. Amen.

Ezra 9:5–9; Tobit 13:2–8; Luke 9:1–6

Thursday, September 25, 2025

Paneled Houses or God’s House “Consider your ways” (Haggai 1:7)

Haggai sounds like a preacher who has heard too many excuses. The people lived in paneled houses while God’s temple sat unfinished. For us it might be new appliances, fancy gadgets, or endless home projects, while the things of God are pushed to tomorrow’s list.

Herod was curious about Jesus but never moved to change. Curiosity without commitment is like a half built house. God asks us to reorder our priorities. Put His work first and the rest of life finally makes sense.

Prayer: Father, help me to build my life around You. Teach me to put Your house before my own comforts. Amen.

Haggai 1:1–8; Psalm 149; Luke 9:7–9

Friday, September 26, 2025

Greater Glory Ahead “Greater will be the future glory of this house than the former” (Haggai 2:9)

Many of us enjoy reminiscing about the good old days, but God reminds His people that the best is not behind them. His Spirit is still with them, and He promises a greater glory to come. Nostalgia is sweet, but hope is sweeter.

Peter declares Jesus as the Christ, and Jesus immediately speaks of the cross. Glory does not skip the hard parts. Hope does not erase sorrow. It carries us through it. The future God is preparing is greater than anything we can imagine. That is worth holding on for.

Prayer: Lord, give me courage when I am tempted to live in the past. Help me trust that Your future glory is better than any memory. Amen.

Haggai 2:1–9; Psalm 43; Luke 9:18–22

Saturday, September 27, 2025

When We Do Not Understand “The Son of Man is to be handed over” (Luke 9:44)

The disciples hear Jesus predict His Passion, but they do not understand. And they are too afraid to ask. We have all been there. The doctor gives a diagnosis, the family struggles, the future feels cloudy, and we want to look away rather than face it.

Zechariah sees Jerusalem surrounded not by walls of stone but by God Himself as a wall of fire. That is the kind of security we need when life makes no sense. Saint Vincent de Paul lived this trust by serving the poor faithfully, even when answers were few. When explanations fail, God’s presence remains.

Prayer: Jesus, when I do not understand, keep me close. Be my wall of fire and my peace. Amen.

Balancing the Books: When Heaven Does the Auditing

If you have ever tried balancing a checkbook, you know the uneasy feeling when the numbers do not add up. You run through receipts, bank slips, and mental calculations, wondering where that missing twenty dollars went. Amos speaks to a society where the math was crooked on purpose. Scales were rigged, ephahs were shrunk, sandals were bought at the expense of the poor. It was creative accounting with devastating human cost. And Amos says plainly, God notices. The divine auditor does not forget a thing.

The Psalmist reminds us that while human ledgers are manipulated, God's economy looks very different. The Lord lifts up the poor from the dust, raising them to sit with princes. God's balance sheet is not about who hoards the most but about who is restored, who is honored, who is lifted. The world may praise cleverness, but heaven praises compassion. The question for us becomes simple and piercing: whose economy am I living in?

Paul adds another column to the ledger: prayer. He urges supplications, petitions, and thanksgivings for everyone, especially leaders. At first that feels like a footnote. But in fact, it is part of the audit. If my prayers are mostly for myself, my balance sheet is tilted. If I am willing to lift up even leaders who make me cringe, then I am living in the freedom of Christ. The act of prayer becomes less about lobbying God and more about adjusting the columns of my own heart, aligning them with His mercy.

Then comes the Gospel with a story that makes every accountant squirm. A steward gets caught cooking the books and, instead of being thrown in prison, he is praised for his cleverness. At first glance, Jesus seems to endorse dishonesty.

But read closely. The master commends the steward not for cheating but for acting with shrewd urgency once he knew his time was short. The lesson is not to cheat better but to choose better. If only the children of light showed as much urgency in pursuing eternal treasure as the children of this world do in securing temporary gain, we would have a very different Church, and perhaps even a different world.

The Gospel lands with that unforgettable bottom line: you cannot serve both God and mammon. It is not that you should not, but that you cannot. Sooner or later, the books will be reconciled, and the heart will be shown to have one master. And Jesus is blunt. If I am not trustworthy in little things, why would heaven trust me with true wealth? If I cut corners in what belongs to another, why would God entrust me with the riches of eternity?

Older adults know this truth in a way that time teaches. It is the little choices, the small daily acts, that add up. A kind word when I would rather snap. A prayer whispered for someone who annoys me. An hour spent visiting rather than complaining. These are the small entries that make a soul trustworthy. They may not impress Wall Street, but they light up heaven's ledger.

Gentle humor also sneaks into the lesson. We laugh at ourselves because we know how easily we try to balance serving God with serving mammon, as if heaven would accept split payments. But Jesus does not want part of us. He wants the whole balance sheet. The joy is that when we hand Him the crooked columns, He balances them not with penalties but with mercy. He takes the debt we could never pay and stamps it "paid in full" with His cross.

So perhaps the best question to carry into the week is this. If heaven did the audit today, what would the books of my life show? Cheating scales or faithful stewardship? Hoarded mammon or generous prayer? When heaven balances the books, it is not to trap us but to free us, because only when the ledgers are honest can we live without fear, and only when God owns the account can we know the joy of being truly rich.
