<i>Guidelines for the Mass on Palm Sunday</i>			
Alternate is Deacon if present			
Lector # 1 will do the Pre Mass Announcements, First Reading, and Parts as Speaker and Chorus.			
Lector #2 will do the Second Reading and Part as Narrator, and General Intercessions.			
After the first reading, Lector #1 needs to move to other side of altar without crossing in front of the altar.			
In the Auditorium, Lector #1 will need to be seated in the center/right section so as not to cross in front of the altar.			
In Church, at the conclusion of the First Reading, Lector #1 will come down from the ambo and walk in the hallway behind the altar to the other side to be ready to use the podium on that side to begin reading the Passion at the appropriate time. Go to the Ambo when the celebrant is to begin the Pasion.			
<u>The second microphone is not as powerful so you will need to project your voice accordingly.</u>
