From My Heart

N ovember is a great time to give thanks. I am reminded of Philippians 1:3-5 where Paul says, "I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now."

Paul found great joy in giving thanks for those who partnered with him in sharing the Gospel and so do I. A good friend of mine invited me to partner with him in sharing the Gospel, his name is Dave Wiliams. Dave and I were buddies for as long as I can remember and we were in the same grade. In our 9th grade year our church began a bus ministry. Our pastor shared the vision and Dave caught that vision. In his heart he wanted to be a Bus Captain. He envisioned God doing mighty things through him, but he had a problem, they wanted adults leading the ministry not 9th graders. Dave would not be deterred, so be prayed and be pleaded with our pastor to give him a chance and he did.

Somewhere in my library is a picture of the beginning of our bus ministry at Hoffmantown Baptist Church. In that picture are all the Bus Captains (We had four buses) and volunteers. In that picture were lawyers, PhD's, men and women who were pillars of the church and my buddy Dave. Dave's vision had come true, but what would he do with that opportunity?

Being a Bus Captain meant that you rode that bus every Sunday morning to pick up kids (We left at 7:30 AM) and to return those kids after church. The responsibility went far beyond that; it involved contacting all those kids every week before Sunday. Every Saturday, Dave hit the trial and visited all his bus riders, but before you could do that you had to find riders. Countless hours were

spent walking neighborhoods, apartment complexes, trailer parks, and playgrounds looking for kids. Once we made contact, we had to talk with their folks and win them over. We were always looking for more kids. Along the way we also found adults who wanted to ride the bus, even famous ones (ask me sometime.). Dave also recruited all the workers on our bus, which was much more than me. Another fellow named Gary stepped up and so did a dozen other teenagers.

What was the result of all this hard work? Dave's bus was one of the best. always picking up between 20 to 30 kids every Sunday, Over the years, Dave not only ministered to kids, but also their families, he knew them and cared for them and prayed for them. He also got to see a lot of those come to know Christ as Savior. How long was Dave a Bus Captain, until he went away for college. That means for four years Dave ran his bus, for four years he spent every Saturday pounding the pavement for Jesus, that means he found and brought hundreds of kids to church. One last thought, when his time was done, he was the only Bus Captain from that original crew still serving.

I am grateful to Dave, and I am thankful he asked me along for the ride. He is a picture of what happens when God calls you to step up and you do, and you hang in there. Some day in Heaven Dave is going to drive that bus again and pick up all his bus riders and it is going to be a mighty BIG Bus!

I am thankful to be partnering with all of you at Blue Ridge to get out the Good News and Looking for Great things at Blue Ridge in November.
