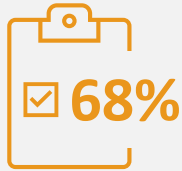


# Cervical Cancer & Chlamydia Screening IN MINNESOTA

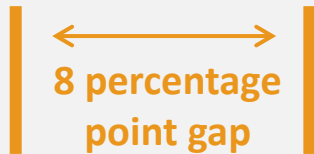
For care delivered in 2023

**cervical cancer screening** in 2023

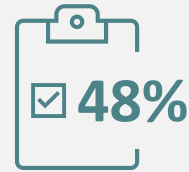


in **cervical cancer screening** rates

## Chlamydia Screening



of females were **up-to-date** on their  
**chlamydia screening** in 2023



in **chlamydia screening** rates between  
females with **commercial insurance**  
(43.6%) and females with **Medicaid  
insurance** (55.4%)  
in 2023



in **chlamydia screening** from  
**2021** (47.7%) to  
**2023** (48.4%)
