- 1) Please be sure to scan the QR code to register your son for fall try-outs and summer information. We use this system as our primary mode of communication. Registering is not a commitment for try-outs, but will be helpful for the next 3 months.
- 2) Summer Trainings Starting on Monday, June 16, we will begin summer trainings, conditioning, and open fields. Practices will take place on Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m. and on Friday mornings from 10:30 am-12:00. (There will be NO training on July 2nd, 4th and 30th). All trainings will be led by the coaches. We try to ensure that at least one coach is present at every training session. Coaches need vacation time with their families too. All players and coaches are being asked to park in the NW lot and walk back to the fields. We will all need to be patient this summer as much of the athletic side of the building will be under construction. The stadium turf is also being replaced which adds to the complexity of our summer training.
- 3) All players must have a current physical for the start of the season. This physical is good for 13 months. Without an updated physical, your son may not try-out on August 1. This can be given to the coaching staff, submitted to the Athletic Office or uploaded to Final Forms any time between now and August 1. If you have a valid physical from a winter or spring sport it will be on file in the AD's office as long as it was submitted to the schools office. Physicals from the middle schools that are still valid will be sent over to Kilbourne as long as they are valid within the last 13 months. Physical Forms may be obtained on the Final Forms website or on the OHSAA website. Pages 4 & 5 are what the physicians need to complete. Prior to the August 1, please log into Final Forms and complete all the paper work (check fall 2025, Soccer)
- 4) There is no summer youth camp this year due to all the construction.
- 5) Kicker's Club Kroger Community Rewards Form. This is one of our successful fundraisers for the boys. If you are a Kroger shopper, by linking your Kroger Card to the Kickers Club, we receive a portion of your total sales to the program. Signing up for the Rewards Program benefits the program, and does <u>NOT</u> change the price you pay for groceries or gas Rewards. Even the purchase of gift cards at Kroger aids our program.
- 6) Car Wash dates are set for June 28th, July 19th and August 16. They will be held in the morning hours 10:00-2:00 in front of Chubby's and Zettler Hardware. For the June 28th and July 19th car washes, we will run two shifts by grade. On August 16th, we will run three shifts by team. An email will be sent out closer to the date with further instructions and times.
- 7) Ohio Wesleyan University Soccer is not offering a team camp this summer. I am currently looking into the possibility of entering a local tournament either on July 19-20 (Excellence in Sportsmanship @ Spindler) or July 26-27 (@ Jonathan Alder).
- 8) Try-outs begin on Friday, August 1 at 8:00 a.m. Be ready to run your 2 mile and make your time!

 Juniors and Seniors are expected to run a 12:30 time. Sophomores a 13:30, and Freshmen a 14:30.

 Those who don't make their time will run it again on Aug 4 at 7:30, and Aug 6...... Be in shape on August 1st...Please! This allows us to work on skills and team strategies. And is helpful in avoiding over use injuries during early camp.
- 9) Expected Fee's coming the week of August 3. Kickers Club Booster Fee \$95. WKHS Pay to Play Fee \$125.
- 10) WKHS Kickers Club Volunteer Form. This explains all the different areas in which our parents help in running our program. Use this form to volunteer. It is expected that every family volunteer in at least one area.
