Chamber spacing, the avoidance of oversized reaming, overall barrel dimensions, and structural integrity all contribute to a superb finished product. Sometimes, one or more items is below the ideal specification and in turn will increase group sizes. Hey; we've got this! BLUEPRINTED ACCURACY TUNING© entails a thorough inspection of your revolver. For \$65, we inspect your crown, bore, forcing cone, barrel/cylinder gap, barrel/chamber alignment, cylinder throats, chambers, cylinder endplay, lockup, and headspace. Included with the inspection, we re-crown the muzzle with our exclusive AccuCrown® bore-centered match crown. It is totally free of burrs and it's uniform with the bore to + - .0001", which is astonishing. Poorly centered crowns, poorly cut crowns, and crowns with burrs cause "bullet wobble". The AccuCrown© is so good, we have an agreement with two High-End 1911 pistol companies to crown their match grade barrels prior to them being used.

AFTER THE INSPECTION? If your revolver needs anything, we contact you and let you know WHAT we found, HOW it impacts grouping potential, and what the PRICE will be to fix it. If you have your gun tuned in this way, we test them for accuracy. We have varying accuracy standards for different guns and calibers. We have many Accuracy Tuned revolvers out there capable of beating Korths, Manurhins, and Spohrs. I will not be shy about it, we are the best at what we do. We have well into 5-figures invested in measuring and machining tools to evaluate and correct deficiencies within the abovementioned areas (that is just in the measuring equipment and cutting attachments!) we mean business regarding accuracy! Colonel Townsend Whelen once said, "Only accurate rifles are interesting". I'll bet the Colonel would say the same thing about revolvers too.

<u>AccuCrown©</u> If you order the BLUEPRINTED ACCURACY TUNING© service, you automatically get this! MOST barrel crowns are flawed. They are either offcenter, have non-uniform depth, have burrs, or all of the above. A huge accuracy killer! Included with the Tuning Package, but on its own \$55 Virtually ALL barrel crowns are several thousands "off". Our unique system, invented over 20 years ago maintains center and depth with the bore to within .0001". Burr-free too!

<u>TruCone©</u> This is a bore-centered method of cutting forcing cones, honing forcing cones, and polishing forcing cones. Available in several angles to accommodate any need. We can correct most issues without removing the barrel. PRICE: Cut New Bore-Centered Forcing Cone: \$65 Truing of Existing Forcing Cone: \$55 - Bore-Centered Polishing of Existing Forcing Cone: \$45 - Smoothing/Truing Forcing Cone Entrance: \$35 All Forcing Cutting/Polishing/Truing Services use equipment that perfectly centers the forcing cone to the bore itself.

CYLINDER THROAT MACHINING: Every chamber has a throat and for the best accuracy every throat needs to be within spec and they all must be the same size within a cylinder. We correct such anomylies! This helps to eliminate flyers, loose groups, spray and splatter. There is also a direct correlation between throat sizing and forcing cone sizing. We machine them so they're acclimated to one another, but it ALL starts with the throats. If we find any out of spec throats or any that are differently sized than the rest within a given cylinder, we can correct that for maximum accuracy potential! PRICE: \$22 Per Throat

<u>MAGIC BALL PRESSURE LAPPING©</u>: This is a method of final-lapping the barrel that duplicates what Colt did once upon a time with their Shooting Master Target Revolvers, Officers Model Target Revolvers, and Old Series Python revolvers. This offers a smoother barrel while maintaining sharp rifling. I learned this method EXACTLY by a retired Colt employee in the 1980s. I have the sizing of the ball, the metallic ratios, and the abrasive used along with the amount of

abrasive mixture. This exceeds what the DIY lapping kits can do by a massive margin. It's not even close. This is a superb final touch to a World Class revolver! Available for Colt's New Series revolvers. PRICE: \$55
